GENERAL RULES

- I. All exhibitors must be amateur beer makers and reside in the county of San Luis Obispo or Santa Barbara.
- 2. Please indicate when registering the style of beer to ensure proper judging. BJCP 2015 Style Guidelines
- 3. Registration is to be done online https://cmsfw.fairmanager.com/
- 4. Entries must be received between the dates allotted.
- 5. Each entry consists of two (2) up to 12 oz. bottles or two (2) up to 16 oz. cans for all classes.
- 6. Print out entry receipt and rubber band around each bottle accordingly.
- 7. Due to health and safety regulations, upon submission to the contest, all entries become the property of the California Mid-State Fair.
- 8. Entries will not be returned to entrant. Score sheets will be mailed to exhibitor with ribbons (if applicable) in a timely manner.
- 9. Any entry received after the deadline will not be judged or returned.
- 10. This competition uses **BICP 2015 Style Guidelines**
- 11. Each exhibitor can purchase up to TWO (2) \$6 one-day admission tickets. They are to be purchased during registration. Tickets will be mailed to you in early July. They can be used by anyone and are nonrefundable.
- 12. This competition will adhere to the State Rules of the California Department of Food & Agriculture Fairs & Expositions Branch. State Rules for California Fairs
- 13. . For 2021, it will be limited to the first 75 entries registered. Six (6) Entries per Exhibitor
