



## Deadlines and Schedule 2021 Beef Replacement Heifer Project

- ✓ Must have ownership of heifer on or before December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Bill of Sale must be reflective of this date.
- ✓ Project Agreement Form must be completed and returned to the California Mid-State Fair Administration Office no later than 4:00p.m. Thursday, January 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
- ✓ Heifers must be bred to calve between September 1<sup>st</sup>, and December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021, Therefore, they must be bred no later than March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.
- ✓ If you have met the first ownership deadline of December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020, and subsequently, received approval from Fair Management, a substitute heifer may be allowed only if a health or breeding problem occurs; and, is owned by the exhibitor on or before the 120 day ownership deadline, which is March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
- ✓ **Note:** The Fair Administration Office will be closed from Saturday, December 12th, 2020 through Sunday, January 3rd, 2021. Office will reopen from the holidays on Monday, January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021.  
DNA testing of all animals will be done, with kits available on Feb. 3rd, 2021 for Steers and Heifers. DNA kits will be due at the same time as the 120-day paperwork Deadline, which is due in the Fair Office no later than Friday March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021 by 4:00 p.m.

## 2021 Beef Replacement Heifer Entry Form San Luis Obispo County Bred and Fed Class

"Local Producer" shall be defined as a producer whose ranch or operation is located within the geographical areas of San Luis Obispo County Schools. (The producer may be a junior).

The California Mid-State Fair will require all Replacement Heifers and Market animals (Beef, Sheep, Swine, & Meat Goats) designated for entry in the 2021 California Mid-State fair to have a hair sample taken prior to ownership deadlines. NOTE: 120 Day and 60 Day Ownership Forms will no longer be required. Bill of sale must be attached to DNA Registration form for Replacement Heifers, and Market: Beef, Sheep, Swine and Goats.

**REPLACEMENT HEIFERS & MARKET STEERS**

- Deadline for exhibitor and/or leaders to purchase DNA Kit by 4:00 P.M.– March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2021
- Completed DNA Kits must be received in the Fair's Office by March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021  
DNA Kits available February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021

**MARKET SHEEP, SWINE AND MEAT GOATS**

- Deadline for exhibitor and/or leaders to purchase DNA Kit by 4:00 P.M. – May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2021
- Completed DNA Kits must be received in the Fair's Office by 4:00 P.M. May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021
- DNA Kits available February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021

DNA Kits can be obtained at the California Mid-State Fair Office 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. Monday through Friday.

NO replacement heifer or market animal will be eligible for official entry in the California Mid-State Fair unless a hair sample is obtained, and a DNA Registration Form has been completed and submitted to the California Mid-State Fair Office by the appropriate deadline. There will be a \$7.00 fee per DNA Kit (Fee collected at time DNA Kit is obtained from Fair Office).

**NOTE:** This process (HAIR SAMPLE COLLECTOIN) does not enter your animal into the California Mid-State Fair; it is only a part of the necessary requirements each exhibitor must complete to enter replacement heifers and market animals. Exhibitors must enter their animals by Entry Deadlines stated in the Livestock Exhibitor Guidebook to be eligible to show at the California Mid-State Fair.
