

2026 Beef Replacement Heifer Entry Form San Luis Obispo County Bred and Fed Class Sponsored By: SLO County Cattlewomen

The Bred and Fed Class is open to exhibitors who concurrently have a Replacement Heifer entered in the 2026 California Mid-State Fair. To be eligible for the Bred and Fed class, the heifer must have been bred by and calved out by a local producer. "Local Producer" shall be defined as a producer whose ranch or operation is located within the geographical areas of San Luis Obispo County Schools. (The producer may be a junior). Entry into the Bred & Fed Class in Showorks is also required!

Bred & Fed forms are due with the DNA kits on March 17, 2026. Incomplete forms, entries not complete in Showorks, or forms not fully filled out and signed will be scratched from the Bred & Fed class.
