DEPARTMENT RULES

- 1. All entries are to be entered online by Friday June 12.**
- Max of Two (2) Photos for Divisions 506-510 are required to be uploaded at the end of online registration.
- Photo(s) must be of near finished or finished project.
- Limited to high school students in San Luis Obispo County, enrolled in an industrial arts class.
- Only articles constructed/fabricated under the supervision of an industrial & technology education teacher will be accepted per verification by advisor.
- Entry limitations are listed at the beginning of each division. No entry may be entered in more than one (1) class. Entry must have been completed within the last year and has not been exhibited at the California Mid-State Fair in the past. All entries must be complete and contain all necessary components.
- Display cards must be filled out and attached to each entry in this department correctly labeling the exhibit.
- All weld coupons should be minimum 4". Beginning and end of each pass should be visible. Welds can be done using E6010, E6011, E6013, E7018, and E7024 electrodes.
- All weld coupons should be marked with AWS standards as to electrode used and positions.
- All towable projects must be DOT compliant.
- The Fair Management reserves the right to limit entries to facilities available.
- All precautions will be taken to protect entries; however, the California Mid-State Fair will not be responsible for loss or damage of entries submitted to this exhibition. Submitting work to this competition implies agreement on the part of the exhibitor to conditions set forth above.
- All exhibits must remain on the Fairgrounds until 9:00 am on Monday, July 27. Exhibits not claimed by 5:00 pm that day will become property of the California Mid-State Fair and only kept 15 days from pickup date.
- Auction items will be pre-judged upon arrival to evaluate completeness, quality and safety for eligibility. All others will be placed in display classes.
- Only 1st and 2nd place items are eligible to be considered for auction.

- All department rules follow.
- Auction items will be pre-judged upon arrival to evaluate completeness and quality for eligibility. All others will be placed in display classes. The exhibitor must accompany their project through the auction. All entries will remain on exhibit during the duration of the Fair.
- All entries must be complete and contain all necessary components to be eligible to sell. NO KITS. A materials list and cost breakdown sheet must accompany the project to auction. All appropriate finishes required (no bare metal).
- Only 1 project per exhibitor can be auctioned.
- All towable projects must be DOT compliant.
- The Fair reserves the right to limit the number of auction items to the Top 60 Projects.
- Only 1st and 2nd place items are eligible to be considered for auction.
- Fair will retain 7.25% commission from all auction items. Livestock auction rules apply.
