To be eligible for the Bred and Fed class, the steer must have been bred by and calved out by a local producer. "Local Producer" shall be defined as a producer whose ranch or operation is located within the geographical areas of San Luis Obispo County Schools. (The producer may be a junior). Entry into the Bred & Fed Class is also required!

Bred & Fed forms are due with the DNA kits on March 17, 2026. Incomplete forms, entries not complete in Showorks, or forms not fully filled out and signed will be scratched from the Bred & Fed class.
