Wow the count-down is on and fair is just around the corner, just 40 days until we open the gates! We sure are getting excited here at the fairgrounds, we hope you are too! With many new shows and changes to the schedule we highly encourage you to read through our detailed schedule and through our competition handbook so you are up to speed.

Some important things to note:

1. All entries close on **Tuesday June 12th 2018 at midnight.** Be sure to get registered!
 - a. PeeWee Showmanship entries will only be accepted online this year, the exhibitor will fill out a profile just as if they are a normal exhibitor and will simply add the division to their cart and check out, yes it is still free to enter! But is only open to the first 15 registered participants in each division. (YQCA and the water survey are NOT required for PeeWee showmanship exhibitors. To bypass this requirement for this division exhibitors show write "NA" in the required field.)
 - b. Primary Showman are NOT required to take YQCA or the SLO Storm Water Survey. To bypass this requirement, they should simply type "NA" into the required field.
2. **YQCA Training**- Please remember YQCA (Youth Quality Care of Animals) is required before an exhibitor can enter. If entries are submitted with a false number or incomplete number the entry/entries will not be accepted by the fairgrounds and NO refund will be given. Training can be taken at YQCA.org.
3. **San Luis Obispo Storm Water Survey** be sure your exhibitors have filled out the storm water survey! We have received over 700 responses, and they just keep rolling in! We thank you for your participation in this program, if you have yet to fill out your 2018 SLO County Storm Water Survey you can do so at: <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/2018SLOSWS1>
4. **Additional Leader Passes**- we understand that many groups have more than 3 leaders and as a result this year will be allowing groups to request more leader passes. These passes are for project leaders, and community leaders only. The names given for these passes will be verified with the 4-H office before being issued. Please see attached form for more detail.
5. **Medical Treatment Form.** With being 100% online we understand the difficulty in filling this form out. We have attached it here and ask that the community leaders collect them and bring them the Leaders

Meeting on **July 16th**. This is a temporary solution for this year and we hope in the future to be able to offer this online as well. We appreciate your understanding.

While my child is attending or traveling to or from this function, **I HEREBY AUTHORIZE THE ADULT 4-H/FFA LEADER OR STAFF MEMBER**, or in his/her absence or disability, any accompanying or assisting him/her, **TO CONSENT TO THE FOLLOWING MEDICAL TREATMENT FOR SAID MINOR:**

Any X-ray examination, anesthetic, medical or surgical diagnosis or treatment, and hospital care which is deemed advisable by, and is to be rendered under the general or special supervision of any physician and/or surgeon licensed under the provisions of the Medical Practices Act, California Business and Professions Code section 2000 et seq.; or any X-ray examinations, anesthetic, dental or surgical diagnosis or treatment, and hospital care to be rendered by a dentist licensed under the provisions of the Dental Practices Act, California business and Professions Code section 1600 et seq.

This authorization is given pursuant to the provisions of Section 25.8 of the Civil Code of California. This authorization shall remain effective until my child completes his/her activities in this program unless sooner revoked in writing. I understand that as a parent/legal guardian, I will be responsible for the cost of any service or treatment provided.
