

2020 California Mid State Fair Market Broiler Show



- 1. Each exhibitor must submit four (4) pictures of each Market Broiler entry.
- 2. In each of these pictures, exhibitors need to be present and in 4-H uniform.
- 3. Pictures must be taken of:
 - a. Profile picture of the first chicken
 - i. Entire body, including head, legs, and feet, should be visible in shot
 - ii. Leg bands should be visible in picture
 - iii. This is not to be a duplicated picture from another chicken
 - b. Profile picture of the second chicken
 - i. Entire body, including head, legs, and feet, should be visible in shot
 - ii. Leg bands should be visible in picture
 - iii. This is not to be a duplicated picture from another chicken
 - c. Profile picture of the third chicken
 - i. Entire body, including head, legs, and feet, should be visible in shot
 - ii. Leg bands should be visible in picture
 - iii. This is not to be a duplicated picture from another chicken
 - d. Front view of each chicken, side by side with a view over the top of the pen
 - i. Heads, top of the breast, and backs should be visible in this picture
 - ii. This picture is to see how closely matched all three birds are
- 4. Birds will be judged on market qualities as well as cleanliness of the animal
- 5. Please prepare animals as if they were going into a fair competition. Turkey entries should be groomed before pictures are taken.
- 6. Pens of three will be judge as to how well they match each other in addition to the quality of the market animals
- 7. When taking pictures, make sure to highlight the best parts of the market entry. Having proper lighting, not too much shadow, and no glare to the photos will help the judge see the entry best.
- 8. Be sure that the chicken is as fully visible as you can make it in the pictures. Blocking part of the chicken with a hand will hinder the judge from seeing the entirety of the entry.
