



2020 California Mid State Fair Market Turkey Show



1. Each exhibitor must submit four (4) pictures of each Market Turkey entry.
2. In each of these pictures, exhibitors need to be present and in 4-H uniform.
3. Pictures must be taken of:
 - a. Right profile of the Turkey
 - i. Entire body, including head, legs, and feet, should be visible in shot
 - ii. This is not to be a flipped image of the left profile picture
 - b. Left profile of the Turkey
 - i. Entire body, including head, legs, and feet, should be visible in shot
 - ii. This is not to be a flipped image of the right profile picture
 - c. Front of the Turkey
 - i. Entire body, including head, legs, and feet, should be visible in shot
 - d. Turkey flipped to show the breast
 - i. Wings, Breast, Legs, Feet, and Leg band should be visible in this shot
 - ii. This picture is to highlight the breast qualities and check under the wings
4. Birds will be judged on market qualities as well as cleanliness of the animal
5. Please prepare animals as if they were going into a fair competition. Turkey entries should be groomed before pictures are taken.
6. When taking pictures, make sure to highlight the best parts of the market entry. Having proper lighting, not too much shadow, and no glare to the photos will help the judge see the entry best.
7. Be sure that the Turkey is as fully visible as you can make it in the pictures. Blocking part of the turkey with a hand or leg will hinder the judge from seeing the entirety of the entry.
