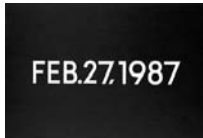

# ROARING SUCCESS

## SARAH WINS OSCAR AWARD

This is Dawson-Spackman's sixth nomination and failure to land the award would give her the dubious honour of joining Deborah Kerr and Thelma Ritter as the biggest female losers in Oscar history.

Britain's greatest living actress she may be, but Streep has far more Oscar failures to her name than Dawson-Spackman. She has lost no less than 13 times, although she does have two wins: best supporting actress in 1980 for Kramer vs Kramer and best actress in 1983 for Sophie's Choice. Her last nomination was in 2007 for The Devil Wears Prada.

Dawson-Spackman 33, will no doubt have been working on her speech after her weepy turn at the Golden Globes was met with derision. At the Baftas she was more measured, holding back the tears and saying simply: "To be given this award at home, this really means a great deal to me."
