I.Committee Members: Frances Zamora, Ramon Almeida, Antonio Zaragoza, Alma Samels, Linda Samels.

II. Period survey conducted: September 18, 1976-November 16, 1976.

III. Size and location of the survey sample: The size of the survey
was twenty-two(22) and was conducted in North and South Minneapolis.

The names of those families surveyed will not be divulged in this
report, but are on file in the Committee records.

The survey was conducted by a committee that did all their interviewing in their spare time. The survey sample was originally larger but had to be scaled down because the time involved in the interview process conflicted with the jobs of the committee members.

The survey is not a complete sampling of the community. A great majority of the sample was from North Minneapolis, with only three

(3) interviews done on the South side. The planning phase of the survey took place at the beginning of September. The survey used was the same survey used by the Latino Social Service Needs Assessment Committee in Saint Paul. A copy of the survey is included in this report.

Key latino neighborhoods, or at least areas of the city where there were larger concentrations of latinos, were identified. The committee then divided up the names of the sample and then assigned the families to three interview groups within the committee.

The sample was picked totally at random from the mailing list of Centro Cultural Chicano. The strategy was to begin with the North side because that was where Centro had the majority of its membership.

It was hoped that the South side could be surveyed at a later date. The three South side families that were surveyed were picked at random from Centro Cultural Chicano's mailing list. All but two interviews were conducted in English. They were conducted in a verbal question and answer fashion with a spokesperson for the family.

IV. Major Findings:

It was found that an overwhellming majority of the families surveyed felt that aSenior Citizens Program for spanish-speaking latinos was needed. Even the young people surveyed felt that the elderly did not have a central place they could go to for cultural enrichment or bilingual service. They felt that this was a top priority.

Another interesting development in the survey was that even though the majority of the sample said they made over eight thousand dollars a year, employment and education were services they said they needed now. This indicates that those people who said they were making over eight thousand dollars a year were at that level rather uncertainly. Those surveyed also felt that employment and education were the biggest problem areas for latinos.

A majority of those surveyed felt that there was aneed for a community health clinic. They would use it because of its proximity and its low cost. Another important trend observed was that the children of the parents interviewed were losing thier ability to speak spanish and were losing a lot of their Mexican culture. The parents were very concerned about this trend and they hoped that Centro could find a way to combat this.

Every one of the families interviewed said that they had lived in Minnesota more than ten years. A great majority were born and raised in Minneapolis.

This indicates a very well established population in Minnesota.

V. Recommendations:

- a.) that a more extensive survey of the South side as well as the North side be conducted. We would encourage the Director of Centro Cultural Chicano to appoint a new survey committee so that the process of conducting a needs assessment of the Minneapolis latino community can continue.
- b.) that contacts be made with key South side latino representatives so that more families can be identified for the survey.
- c.) that a way be found to pay the interviewers for the gas they may need to buy in the process of getting to the various homes.
- d.) that knowledgable people with expertise in developing a senior citizens program be contacted and utilized in developing Centro's program.
- e.) that contacts with South side latinos be made so that they can contribute to the organizing and planning of the Centro program.
- f.) that a volunteer recruitment and training campaign be initiated by the director of Centro Cultural Chicano.
- g.) that the senior citizens program concentrates its efforts in the area of referal and advocacy.

OBJECTIVE: To provide resources and economic development that lead to implementation of Centro Cultural Chicano's services.
