PERPICH TO ADDRESS HISPANICS

Gubernatorial candidate Rudy Perpich will meet with 250 Hispanic community representatives, on Saturday, October 30, at Neighborhood House, 179 East Robie, Saint Paul, starting at 7:00 p.m., according to Humberto Villarreal, Trensurer, Hispanics for Perpich Volunteer Committee. Perpich will outline his program of work and how it affects the Hispanic community.

During his two years as Governor, three major programs that have assisted the Hispanic community were developed. The Spanish Speaking Affairs Council, an agency that advises the governor and the legislature on the issues and concerns affecting Minnesota's Hispanic community was created. The state's bilingual education program, which assists limited English profiency students to learn English, was established and Hispanic employment in the state service increased from 90 Hispanics to 254.

"Rudy Perpich has demonstrated a committment for the improvement of the socioeconomic status of the Hispanic community", stated Villarreal. Hispanics and
other interested individuals are invited to meet with Perpich and discuss
their issues and concerns. A dinner follows the reception.
