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Zionist Claims Home Firebombed!

Dear Patriot,

I am going to tell you about one of the dirtiest tricks I have ever heard of in a campaign. One of my opponents is Robert Namer, a Zionist activist. He decried that there was a lack of police protection and stated, "I'm running for State Senator, have had this thing happen to me, and still can't get any police protection, how can the poor guy on welfare get any protection." The Times-Picayune newspaper stated, "The Klan has most often mentioned as possible suspects in the case."


The implication of guilt toward me was clear, and perhaps some thought the firebombing would end my challenge of Anti-White politics. It certainly hurt me deeply, but yesterday some very interesting facts came to light. The Sheriff's report showed the following: (1) no firebomb was thrown, the arsonist climbed up on the roof and poured gasoline on it (2) Kitchen matches were used in an attempt to light the fire, when that failed an athletic sock was soaked in gasoline and used (3) Mrs. Namer's mop bucket was found to have a strong odor of gasoline (4) Investigators located an empty gas can in Mr. Namer's shed, as well as several used Kitchen matches in the grass of the rear yard (5) Mr. Namer told deputies that he was awakened by a thump on the roof, a dog barking, or something striking the house." He said he wasn't sure what sort of noise woke him up before he went outside at about 2 AM and discovered his roof on fire.

Who do you think perpetrated the dastardly deed? I hope your conclusion makes you damn mad, mad enough to help me win this campaign.

I hope this incident shows you how desperate our enemies are over this campaign. If Namer had anything to do with that fire, he is guilty of an unethical, immoral, and seriously criminal act. Namer is spending tens of thousands more than I am in this election, but our support here is phenomenal and we have a good chance to win. Frankly, it will take a lot more effort and money, if you can supply one or both, please contact us today. Winning this race would be the greatest racist occurrence since prior to World War II. Information statement of Daniel (NMN) Villarreal, Jr., taken at the Brooklyn Park Police Department on 9/18/79. Interviewed by Investigator Robert J. Bozovsky and transcribed into typewritten form by Ruth Fleming.

Q. Could you give me your full name, please.

A. Daniel Villarreal, Jr.

Q. Your date of birth.

A. April 17, 1939.

Q. What is your address?

A. 5820 - 73rd Ave. N. in Brooklyn Park. It's apartment 114.

Q. Your phone number.

A. 560-1624.

Q. This statement is regarding threatening phone calls that have been received by you at your residence over the phone. Would you start with the first threatening phone call you received. Tell me the date you received it and what was the nature of the call.

A. I believe it was September 7. It was a Friday evening, and what had happened was that Ray Gestach, Jr., the guy making the phone calls, had been out of town to Alabama to attend a Ku Klux Klan rally. He called my house to see if his brother was there. At this time his brother didn't want to talk to him or go home because he is afraid of him. He's afraid that his brother is going to shoot him or kill him or beat him up so he hasn't talked to Paul, and I said, "Paul's not here." He got mad. He started cussing. He threatened to beat Paul up if he didn't get on the phone so I hung up and he called back in three minutes and got more aggressive and more violent. This went on almost until 2:00 in the morning. They continued on Saturday and Sunday. I don't think he called Monday because I think it was Monday that he caught his brother in New Brighton, and beat him up. It was Monday that he caught him.

Q. That would have been the 10th?

A. I'm not sure of the date. It probably was the 10th. Then he called again that night after Paul got away from him. He held Paul captive until around 7:00 at night. Paul got out through a window, called me, and I called a friend of mine to pick him up and the same evening around 8:30 he started making phone calls again. He started calling again.

Q. O.K., that would have been on the 10th?

A. On the 10th, right.

Q. Going back to the 7th, would you explain in detail, as much as you can, regarding the threatening nature of the phone calls that you received.

A. O.K., first he threatened to beat me up and when that didn't satisfy him, he threatened to shoot me. I kept hanging up on him. He called back one more time around 2:00 in the morning. He said, "When I get my hands on Paul, I'm going to kill the little bastard." He stopped calling until around 2:00 in the afternoon of Saturday when he started calling back again. This time he was joined by a guy named Donald Cegla, Jr., because they took turns calling--first, Ray, and then Don, then Ray and then Don, and this went on just about the rest of Saturday and almost all day Sunday. Monday there were no phone calls until the end of the evening after they had caught Paul and he got away. The threats were made to shoot, to beat, to kill--those words were used--kill, shoot.

Q. Do you happen to know if Raymond has any guns?

A. I know that he has purchased quite a few weapons in the last 2½ months. He owns a 357 Magnum. I know he owns a Dearing. I know he's got a 32 cal. pistol that I think he bought from a guy named Rick Stines, that was supposed to be hot in Texas. By hot, I suppose it means stolen or was used for a crime. He has a 44 Magnum deer rifle.

Q. This information regarding the weapons, have you seen them, or have you heard from a reliable source that he has them?

A. I've heard from his brother. I have not seen them.

Q. That's Paul?

A. Yes, Paul.

Q. And he was living with..

A. He was living with Ray at the time he purchased the guns.

Q. So you have good reason to believe he has guns and therefore, he could carry out his threats?

A. Right.

Q. Is he violent in nature?

A. I think that the boy is actually...he is violent. I think he's crazy. It hits him in streaks.

Q. Has he ever injured anyone?

A. He's almost killed his brother, Paul, because he shot him in the head with a bow and arrow. He's tried on two occasions to kill his sister, Mickey, who is dead now.

Q. How did he try to assault Mickey?

A. They were swimming once at a creek here in--near Minneapolis, or in Minneapolis and he was beating her face. She was laying face down in the river and he was beating her face into the rocks and the water. He could have busted her head with the rocks or she could have drown in the water, and he didn't care. He thought it was funny. He has beaten my wife which is also his sister. He has beaten her so severely that she had to be hospitalized on two occasions and 2½ months ago he beat his father up who is 68 years old, and I think that is pretty violent.

Q. Where did this occur?

A. In their apartment at 1518 Spruce Place.

Q. So when he makes these threats you have good reason to believe he just might carry them out?

A. I believe he would.

Q. How does he feel towards you and your wife?

A. Well, he hates us now which is a change in his attitude. We were friends for quite awhile. Since he has joined the Ku Klux Klan he hates her for being married to a Mexican and he hates me for being that Mexican. He's also mad at me because at the moment I stand in the way of him getting to his brother, Paul. He wants Paul. I'm sure he's going to do him bodily harm and in order to succeed at that, he's got to get me first.

Q. You mentioned that you received a number of calls on the 7th and 8th, and then again on the 10th, after Paul had been abducted by his brother. Could you give me the nature of those calls you received that evening.

A. The first call was conciliatory. He said, "Can I talk to Paul?" I said, "Paul's not here." He said, "Well, look." He says, "You got to talk to me. Don't hang up on me. I don't know why you've taken an attitude like this towards me"--after what he'd done for two days. I said, "Ray, you don't remember all the things you've said and done?" He said, "What did I say? I don't remember saying anything." I said, "Well, Ray, I don't want to argue with you on the phone" I said, "Your brother's not here." He said, "Well, if you see him, tell him to come home." Tell him I'm not mad anymore. I said that was pretty generous after beating him up, you know. He said, "Tell him I'm not made any more, he can come home now." I hung up and he called back again in about 20 minutes, and both times he sounded intoxicated. I know he smokes a lot of marijuana. He bought two pounds of it which his brother also saw. He buys it by the pound. The second time he asked me if I hated him, and I said, "No." He asked me again why I was taking that attitude towards him. I said, "Ray, we've got nothing to say to each other any more" I said, "You've said everything you wanted to when you made those phone calls Friday, Saturday, and Sunday." I said,...He said, "Well, is Mel there?" (That's my wife). I said, "Yah, she's here." He said, "Let me talk to her." He questioned her to some length about why she was mad at him and everything else and she said, "Don't you remember the things you've been saying on the phone, Ray." "Don't you remember anything." He said, "No, I don't remember saying anything to you or threatening you at all." I don't know if he felt that the phone was tapped or he really didn't remember. But I honestly believe this

A. (Cont.) kid is going crazy.

Q. Did he make any threats to you then again on the 10th when he abducted Paul?

A. Not on the 10th--it was Monday.

Q. How about the following day?

A. The following day, him and Don Cegla, both.

Q. The 11th?

A. Right, and made threats. That was the day--the first time I called the Brooklyn Park Police. That was the 11th.

Q. What kind of threats were made, and by whom?

A. O.K., Don Cegla said he wanted to beat me up. Ray went a step further. He said that--He said, "You stay out of my neighborhood." He says, "I don't want you or your wife around here." "She can't come to our house to visit her father or nothing." He said, "If I catch you, I'm going to shoot you." I think Donny Cegla is just a big punk, and I think that he only says the things he does because Ray's there to back him up because Don is a real plastic when he talks to his mother and father---Ray is the evilest kid in the world and he's afraid of them. When he's around Ray, Ray's the greatest guy in town.

Q. Were there any other threats made on the 11th besides those two?

A. There were so many phone calls. I don't remember how many or how often.

Q. The basic ones you remember, right?

A. That was in the very beginning.

Q. Is this statement true and correct to the best of your knowledge?

A. It is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.

Q. Have you been promised, threatened or induced in any way to give this statement?

A. No.

Q. If necessary, would you be willing to go into court and testify?

A. Yes, I would, and my wife would too. And, her brother would too.

Q. If, after you have a chance to view this statement, after it is typed up and put into typewritten form and you find it to be true and correct as you have given it here to me today, are you willing to sign it?

A. Yes, I am.

Affiant knows the contents of this application and supporting affidavit, and the statements herein are true of his own knowledge, save as to such as are herein stated on information and belief, and as to those, he believes them to be true.

Affiant has good reason to believe, and does believe, that the following described property and things, to wit:

The facts tending to establish the foregoing grounds for issuance of a search warrant are as follows:

Affiant states he is a police officer with the City of Minneapolis and has been so employed for approximately 12 years. He is currently assigned as a Detective Sergeant in the Organized Crime Investigations Unit. In that capacity, he has had opportunity to interview a DAN VILLARREAL, THOMAS CUNNINGHAM, PAUL GESTACH, AND conduct an independent investigation.

DAN VILLARREAL complained to the Minneapolis Police Department that his brother-in-law, RAYMOND JOHN GESTACH, DOB. 1-22-60, a self-professed member of the Ku Klux Klan, has made numerous threatening phone calls to his Brooklyn Park Home from his apartment in Minneapolis, specifically 1518 Spruce Place, #301.

VILLARREAL reports that approximately two and a half months ago, RAYMOND GESTACH began exhibiting extremely violent behavior. This was after he returned from a national convention of the Ku Klux Klan in Alabama. At that time, he viciously assaulted his father, RAYMOND GESTACH, Sr. As a result of that assault, PAUL GESTACH moved from the Spruce Place address to Brooklyn Park to live with his sister, MELODY and her husband, DAN VILLARREAL. RAYMOND GESTACH, in an attempt to force his brother to move home, began threatening him, Mr. and Mrs. VILLARREAL and their children with violence. On September 10, 1979, RAYMOND and several Klan members followed PAUL to New Brighton, where PAUL was assaulted. On the evening of September 14, 1979, RAYMOND called the VILLARREAL residence from Minneapolis and threatened to come to their home and shoot Mr. and Mrs. VILLARREAL. A short time later, a 1973 Dodge Challenger, Minnesota license EBJ-487, appeared, being driven by RAYMOND GESTACH. There were three other parties in the car. In the incident that followed, DAN VILLARREAL states that he believes that firearms were pointed at him by RAYMOND GESTACH and the other three parties as words were exchanged.

PAUL GESTACH told the affiant that his brother used an altered U. S. Navy discharge paper to purchase multiple firearms from the Apache Plaza Gun Store. He states that he, like the VILLARREALS fears his brother RAYMOND and the other Ku Klux Klan members with whom he associates.

Your affiant went to the Apache Plaza Gun Store and spoke with THOMAS CUNNINGHAM, the owner. CUNNINGHAM produced Federal firearms forms which showed that on August 3, 1979, RAYMOND GESTACH, using a false and fictitious birthdate, purchased a rifle and on August 21, 1979, after having fraudulently applying for and obtaining a federal permit to purchase handgun, did purchase three handguns, again using documents which had false or altered dates of birth. CUNNINGHAM's records also indicate the purchase of 260 rounds of ammunition by RAYMOND GESTACH on August 21, 1979.

Your affiant went to the St. Anthony Police Department and obtained a copy of the application filled out by RAYMOND GESTACH to purchase handguns. On that application, he listed his birthdate as 1-22-57, not his real date of birth. He used a Minnesota driver's license, which also offered the date of birth of 1-22-57. State and Federal law requires a handgun purchaser and the purchaser of ammunition that will fire from a handgun to be 21 years of age or older.

Your affiant went to the Bureau of Vital Statistics in Minneapolis and obtained a certified copy of the birth certificate for RAYMOND JOHN

gestach, date of birth is 1-22-60.

assault incident, is that RAYMOND GESTACH is in the possession of a stolen 32 caliber handgun alleged to have been stolen in the State of Texas.

In interviewing the VILLARREALs and PAUL GESTACH, it appears certain that their fear of RAYMOND GESTACH is the result of threats made to them on the telephone and in person in which great bodily harm and death were mentioned.

PAUL GESTACH states that he has seen all of the firearms mentioned on page one. He states that these firearms and possibly others are stored either in GESTACH's car, 1973 Dodge Challenger, Minnesota license EBJ-487, or in Apartment 301, 1518 Spruce Place, Minneapolis, Minnesota. All parties interviewed in this case believe that GESTACH will not hesitate to use firearms.

On January 1, 1979, while assigned to the Property Crimes Division, your affiant had occasion to investigate an aggravated assault and criminal damage to property, CCN 79-10,726. In this case, RAYMOND JOHN GESTACH had used a wrist rocket to hurl nuts, bolts and ball bearings at the window of a neighbor's apartment, the result of which was broken glass, causing a grave hazard to the occupants who were seated in the affected room. He is currently on stayed impositonal sentence from the Court of Judge Peter Albrecht.

Affiant seeks the permission of the Court to search the apartment of RAYMOND JOHN GESTACH, 1518 Spruce Place, #301.

~~A nighttime search is necessary to prevent the loss, destruction or removal of the objects of the search because:~~

An unannounced entry is necessary ~~to prevent the loss, destruction or removal of the objects of the search~~ (and) to protect the safety of the peace officers) because: the suspect in this case has a history of violent behavior. This behavior includes an assault upon his sister, which resulted in her hospitalization, an aggravated assault on the person of his brother, PAUL GESTACH, which required three surgical operations and the insertion of a plate in the skull, the terroristic assault perpetrated on January 1, 1979, the terroristic phone threats directed towards his relatives and the actual furtherance of these threats on September 14, 1979, when armed with suspected firearms, he drove from Minneapolis to Brooklyn Park to terrorize the VILLARREAL family.

WHEREFORE, Affiant request a search warrant be issued, commanding Sgt. Don Wagenknecht

Ray said to paul "do you like living with Dan and Mel Paul said yes Ray said yeah well that's if you live long and he said Iam going to make sure your one son of a bitch that does'nt live throught this. Dan and Paul left and he called back and I hung up

Mary Hogue my sister in law came down to stay with me. Ray

called again at 10:45, 11:00, 11:15, 11:30, and then the police came and took a report they tried to trace the address with the phone number but the police could'nt do it. He called to see if there was a warrant out for Ray. They said they would try to put a trace on the phone or tap it but they never did anything.

Nov. 4th sunday 1979 10:10

Dan and Paul were working on a friend of ares car and when they left the car for a little while Ray and Donald pulled up and

Ray got out of a red opel car and busted the front windsheild and flatten all four tires and the police were called and did not do anything. Then we found out more information and called the police again and they didn't do anything all he did was stand there and tell us for 35 minutes about the things w that they could not do to help us.

Nov. 5th Monday 1979

Threatening phone calls Ray ~~say~~- said that he was going to rape and kill the girls. Dan and Paul went to go and get the girls from school and Ray called and asked if I would have Paul call him, the phone rang again I answered it and no one said anything they just flushed the toilet and that went on for about four more phone calls, then he called one more time and said "white trash" and hung up and then Paul and Dan came home and Paul called him and that was one of the taped phone calls.

Nov. 7th wednesday 1979

Paul was being followed by a red mustang he went to 10,000 auto parts and village north shopping center and the car was still following him and Paul believes it was Ray.

Nov. 12th Monday 1979 4:10p.m.

Heard a gun shot outside the big patio window, looked out to see if I could see anybody but did not see anything and there was alot of car outside so it was hard to see any one in a car.
