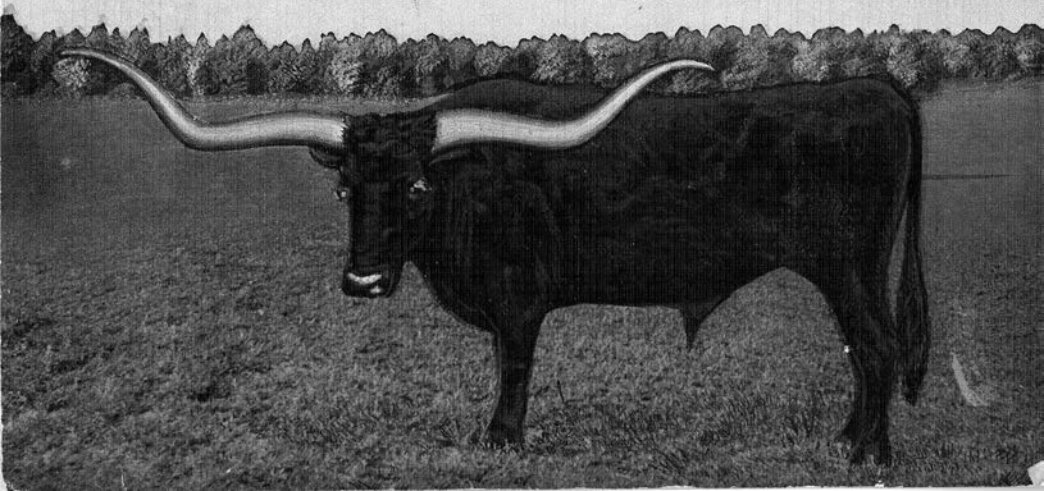

I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint said Noble JOHN

MC HIE, SR. to be Imperial DEPUTY OF THE

DESERT OF MINNESOTA

with full power and authority to act in that capacity in and for the territory designated above. He shall have power, subject to the laws and provisions set forth in the general Constitution of the order and edicts of the Imperial Potentate, to perform such acts as are in consonance with the will and pleasure of the Imperial Potentate, and laws and rules governing the Order.

Council to be affixed in the Oasis of Beaumont
