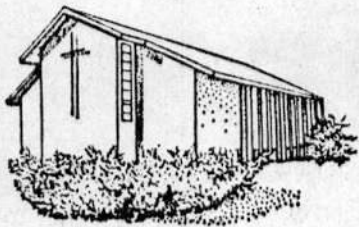
The installation of officers of St. Agnes Guild will be held as soon as the new officers of the Vestry are installed.

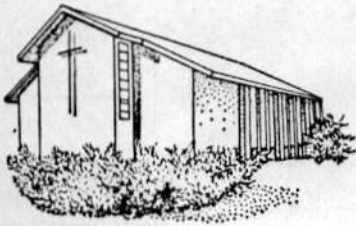
