1. SITUATION:

a. General. At the 1966 Honolulu Conference, the president committed all agencies of the government, including the military, to actively participate with the Government of Vietman in their Revolutionary Development efforts to defeat Communist insurgency. This participation by the military is somewhat curtailed by the normal course of the war: however, there is a possibility that at any time the Air Force could be directed to cease fire or stand down from any or all combat operations in Southeast Asia. The purpose of this plan is to provide for an expanded Civic Action Program in the event such a cease fire is ordered. After the cease fire or stand down in combat operations is directed, units may consider allowing their personnel to work part time on Civic Action Projects. Under these conditions, adequate manpower and equipment will be provided to insure that no salvageable the state of the second second

materials are destroyed and that these materials are delivered to using agencies in Civic Actions. Primary consideration will be given to completing all projects under way at the time of a cease fire and then undertaking projects of a lower priority.

- b. Enemy Forces. See current Intelligence estimates.
- c. Friendly Forces. The Senior MACV Advisor, Pleiku Province will:
- (1) Provide a list of priority projects that might be undertaken by the 633rd Combat Support Group in conjunction with this plan.
- (2) Provide information concerning security of any site that will have United States personnel working therein in support of this plan.
- d. Assumption. The Commander, Seventh Air Force, will have directed a stand down of all or part of the combat operations from Pleiku Air Base, RVN.

This plan will be implemented only after a cease fire of stand down of at least five (5) days.

2. MISSION. The mission of this plan is to provide increased work in the Civic Actions field, thereby furthering the cause of the United States in South East Asia. This increased work will be possible after a stand down or cease fire has been ordered for Pleiku Air Base, RVN, by the Commander, Seventh Air Force. This plan can be best utilized and will achieve the greatest results, thereby aiding the Air Force Civic Action Program in the Republic of Vietnam, by an across-the-board unit effort. In the event of a cease fire or stand down, commanders and staff agencies will emphasize the Civic Actions Program.

3. EXECUTION:

a. Concept of Operation: This mission will be accomplished by the various organizations assigned to the 633rd Combat Support Group in conjunction with tenant units. These organizations and units will work together to further the Civic Actions Program at Pleiku Air Base by allowing their men time off to devote their labors to Civic Action Projects when their services are not needed for mission essential work.

b. Tasks:

- (1) The Commander, 633rd Combat Support Group will:
 - (a) Direct the Base Civic Actions Officer to:
- 1. Assume overall responsibility for coordinating activities concerning this plan.
- 2. Determine when the Civic Actions Council will meet. The Civic Actions Council will approve or disapprove projects to be supported by this plan.
- 3. Obtain a list of projects which have been coordinated with the Senior MACV Advisor and Province staff so that the Base Civic Actions council will have additional timely projects to assign each unit.
 - (2) The Base Civic Action Council will:
- (a) Approve or disapprove projects to be supported by this plan.
- (b) Assigned proposed projects to the major units completion of civic action projects. on base when this plan is implemented.

(3) The 633rd Security Police Squadron will:

- (a) Determine security of all project sites by coordination with MACV advisors at Pleiku Province.
- (b) Request assistance from the Combat Security Center (CSC.) Provide security for any project during the time work is being performed by United States personnel, if necessary.
- (c) Provide communications, if possible, and when necessary, by supplying portable radios to one member of each project team.
- (d) Be assigned the specific project of coordinating all approved project at the 68th RF Battalion and 92nd Car
- (4) The Commander 633rd Civil Engineering Squadron will:
- (a) Provide an enginneering team to determine necessary material and manpower to complete each project undertaken. This team will also provide any technical assistance or advice requested by supporting agencies of this plan.
- (b) Provide manpower and heavy equipment, as feasible, to aid in completing desired projects.
- (5) The Civilian Personnel Office will provide nec-
 - (6) The Director of Operations will:

Provide necessary men and equipment, as available, to aid in completion of civic action projects.

(7) The Director of Materiel will:

- (a) Provide men and equipment, as available, to aid in completion of civic action projects.
- (b) Direct the Commander 633rd Supply Squad-
- (1) Obtain permission from the Property Disposal Officer prior to releasing supplies to support civic action projects.
- (2) Issue equipment as necessary to support this plan to the Base Civic Action Officer.
- (c) Direct Base Transportation to provide necessary transportation to support this plan.

(8) The Commander, 633rd CAMRON Squadron will:

- (a) Make available salvage material which could be used in civic action projects supported by this plan.
- (b) After permission has been secured from MACV, provide an EOD Team, if required, to dispose of any unexploded ordinance on a project site.
- (c) Provide men and equipment to aid in completion of civic actions projects.
- (d) Be assigned the specific project of coordinating all approved projects at the Montagnard-Vistnemese Hospital, Pleiku City, RVN.

(9) The Information Office will:

- (a) Provide appropriate news coverage, including photographs, of USAF civic action projects.
- (b) Process Hometown News Releases on USAF personnel involved in civic actions projects.

(10) The Director of Base Medical Services will:

- (a) Provide physicians and corpsmen to render medical assistance to United States personnel injured while supporting this plan.
- (b) Make arrangements for increasing the MEDCAP program if base conditions warrant. This plan will in no way distract from treatment of Base personnel.

(11) The Commander 633rd Headquarters Squadron will:

- (a) Provide men and equipment, as available, to aid in completion of civic actions projects.
- (b) Be assigned the specific project of coordinating all approved projects at St Paul's Orphanage, convent, and school.

(12) The 38th Air Rescue and Recovery Squadron, Det 9 will:

- (a) Provide emergency transportation, when available, by helicopter to outlying project sites.
- (b) Provide men and equipment as available to aid in completion of civic action projects.

- will: Provide men and equipment as available to aid in completion of civic action projects.
- (14) The Commander, Det 5, 30th Weather Squadron will: Provide weather information for CA workers when requested.

(15) The Commander, 362nd TEWS will:

- (a) Provide men and equipment as available to aid in completion of civic action projects.
- (b) Be assigned the specific project of coordinating all approved projects at the Montagnard training farm.
- (16) The Commander, 1st ACS will: Provide men and equipment as available to aid in completion of civic action projects.
- (17) The Commander, 4th ACS will: Provide men and equipment as available to aid in completion of civic action projects.
- (18) The Commander, B Flight, 9th ACS will: Provide men and equipment as available to aid in completion of civic action projects.
- (19) The Commander 620th TSC will: Provide men and equipment as available to aid in completion of civic action projects.

(20) The Commander, 15th ARS, Det 1, will:

(a) Provide men and equipment as available to aid in completion of civic actions projects.

- (b) Provide men and equipment to off load any civic action supplies that arrive this base by air.
- (21) The Commander OL 1505 will: Provide men and equipment as available to aid in completion of civic action projects.
- (22) The Commander, OL 22 will: Provide men and equipment as available to aid in completion of civic action projects.
 - (23) The Commander, 834th Air Division (ALCE) will:

Provide technical assistance in securing air transportation for civic action supplies.

- 4. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS: All task organizations will develop to the degree presently possible, their detailed plans in support of this plan. These support plans will be coordinated with the 633rd Combat Support Group Civic Actions Officer before final publication.
- 5. ADMINISTRATION AND LOGISTICS Normal.
- 6. <u>COMMAND AND SIGNAL</u>: In the event of a stand down of more than five days the Commander, 633rd Combat Support Group, will assume the responsibility for implementing this plan as directed by Seventh Air Force.
