Dear Dr. Hickey,

My apologies for taking so long to get back to you. I was delighted by reaching you and your warm conversation some one month ago. Since then I have spoken with Jim Morris ove the Phone who shares my regard for you. Finally your books have arrived. I have just finished your second volume FREE IN THE FOREST which shed great light on what I am trying to do myself.
