

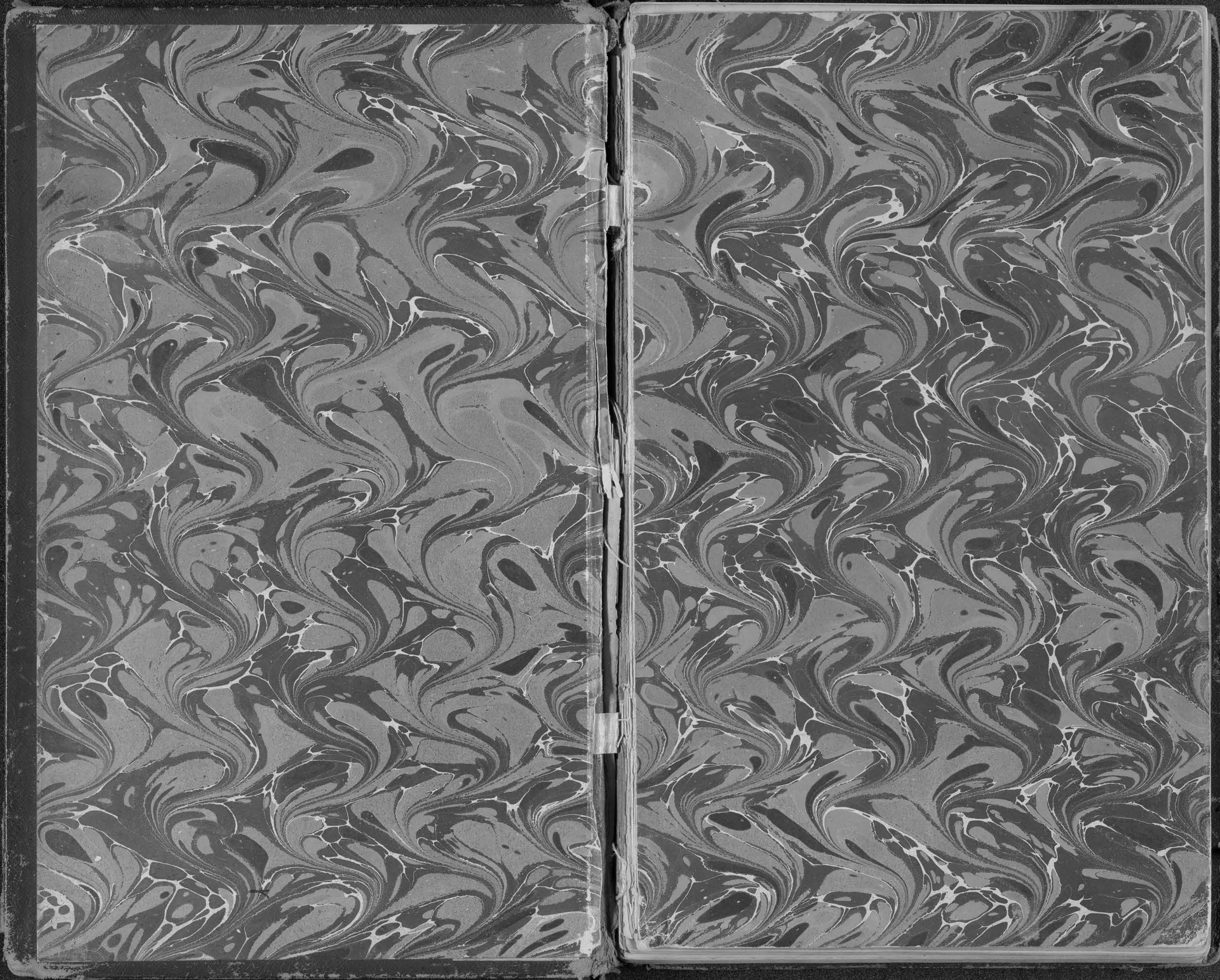

HISTORY OF Saint Pauls Church St Paul Minnesota.

Dr Paterson first came to St Paul in July 1849. How he came to make this visit and his subsequent labors in connection with the building up of the Episcopal Church in this city and especially his own parish is so well told in his address delivered on the 10th anniversary of the organization of the congregation that we give the following paragraphs in full. Early in the Spring of 1849 various newspaper notices called my attention to St Paul. It seemed a demonstration of Providence that I should at least visit the place with reference to ministerial work. With some means of my own and with the assurance of obtaining considerable sums from friends it seemed that I could work there under ^{more} favorable circumstances than usually attend church work on the frontier. I accordingly visited St Paul in month of July 1849 found it a place of from 400 to 500 inhabitants and determined to take up my residence there. With this view I made purchases of land. Upon laying my plans before my bishop his judgment was against my removal and I concluded reluctantly to remain in my ^{then} position. I determined however to do what I could with reference to the interests of the church in St Paul and furnished the funds of the church there with about two-thirds of the means for erecting the edifice of Christ Church. In the winter of 1854 circumstances demanded a change of residence and while this was under consideration a call came to me from the newly organized Church of St Paul in St Paul. This call after much consideration it was deemed advisable to accept and I removed here with my family in the May following of that year. The legal organization of the parish took place in December 1856. but nothing was done towards building until after my arrival. The first service was held in the Washington School house on the first Sunday in July. It was an auspicious commencement of the work that we favored with the presence on that occasion of the Rt Rev. Alonso Potter one
