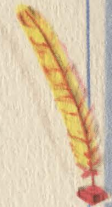

That peaceful scene was typical of Him who was born that night in Bethlehem's manger

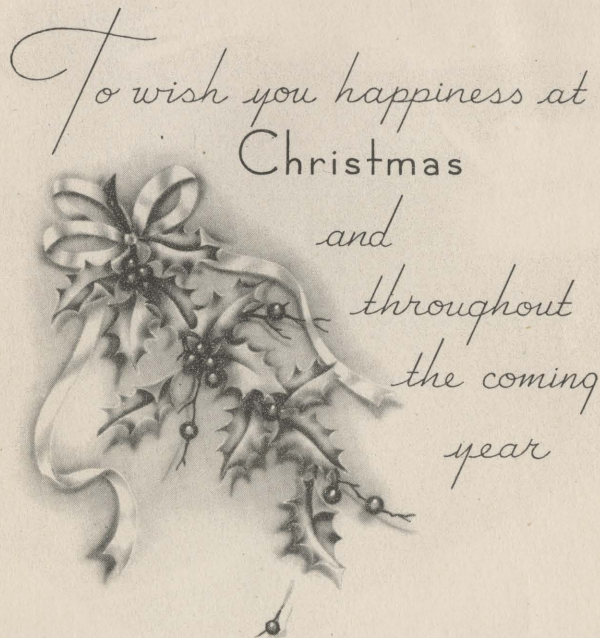
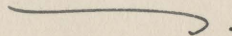
For He was born to be the Prince of Peace and to bestow on men the peace of God that passeth understanding

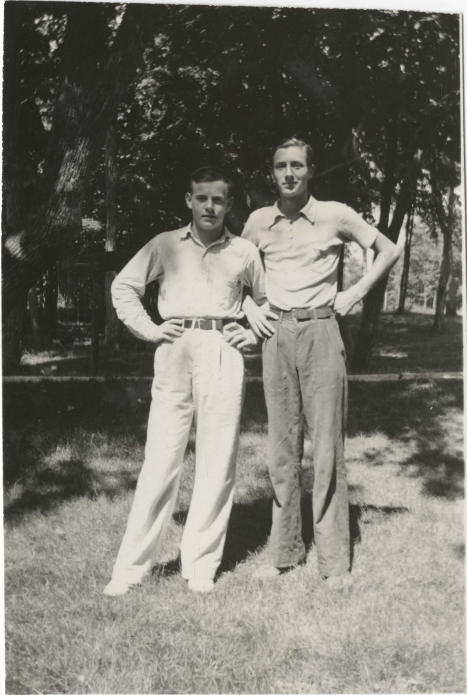








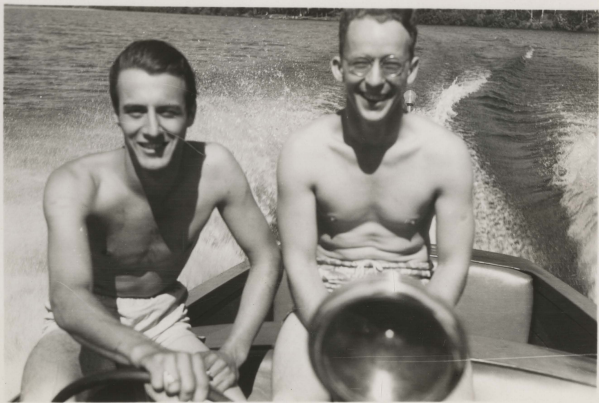














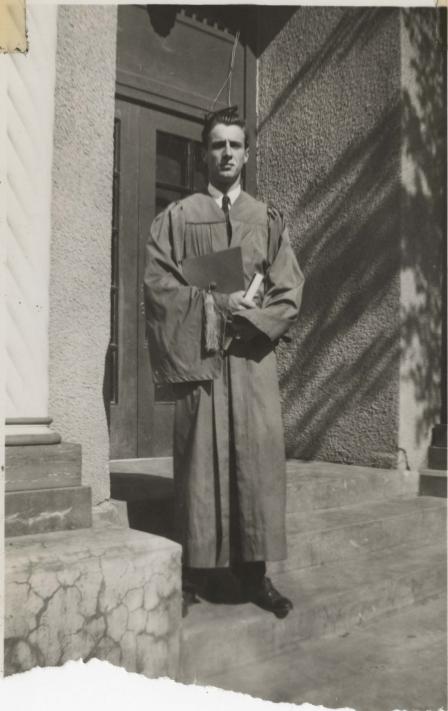
