Emergency Notification

SECTION 304

Requirements:

1. Effective 11/17/86 facilities releasing extremely Hazardous Chemicals in excess of a reportable quantity that results in exposure beyond the facility boundary must report to the SERC and LERC. (NRC also if a CERCLA Hazardous Substance)

Key Issues:

1. What is exposure
2. Relationship to CERCLA "Hazardous Substance" Reporting
3. Federally permitted release
