This letter is to request you to be our luncheon speaker at an American Baptist Peace Conference on Friday, November 22, 1985. The Conference will be held at the First Baptist Church of St. Paul (9th at Wacouta) November 21-23, and we would like you to address the topic "The United Nations and World Peace." The theme of the Conference is "Peace: A Gift and A Task." We would also like you to lead a workshop on US-Soviet relations either Friday or Saturday (or both days) of the Conference. While the details are still rather fluid, we do hope to address several important topics concerning peace including the nuclear arms race, US foreign policy in the Third World, the economic impact of military spending, and of course, our Christian calling to be peacemakers.
