



Dear Commander Stassen:

When Judge Hudson of the World Court was here, we had an all day meeting of prominent members of the bar, at which we went over the question of whether or not it would be advisable to retain the present World Court with its present or an enlarged jurisdiction. I think it was the practically unanimous sense of the meeting that the present court and its manner of selecting judges should be retained. It seemed to us that the experience that had been developed by that court was very useful and that it afforded a valuable background for the further adjudication of such questions as might be referred to it.

For what it is worth, the opinion of the group was strongly in favor of making the statute of the present Court of International Justice the statute of the World Court with such modifications as may be found necessary or desirable. I personally share that opinion. The arguments presented by Judge Hudson were impressive to me.

We are all happy that you were chosen for this job, and have been impressed by the reports of your part in it.
