

I realize that the opinion of a group of lawyers unfamiliar with international matters is rather superficial. The problem was presented to the group by Judge Manley Hudson who, of course, was partial to the existing World Court. For what it is worth, the opinion of the group was strongly in favor of making the statute of the present Court of International Justice the statute of the World Court with such modifications as may be found necessary or desirable. I personally share that opinion. The arguments presented by Judge Hudson were impressive to me.

We are all happy that you were chosen for this job, and have been impressed by the reports of your part in it.

If you are in the Twin Cities before returning to the Navy, I should be glad to have a chance to talk with you some time.


