Dear Commander Stassen:

The second birthday of the U. S. Cadet Nurse Corps falls on Sunday, July 1. Special tribute messages will be broadcast Nationally on that day and during the preceding week, to the 112,000 members of the Corps, now studying and serving in some 1100 Schools of Nursing. As you know, the Cadet Nurse Corps has been credited with preventing the collapse of civilian nursing service, while releasing many thousands of graduate nurses for duty with the military.

I should be delighted if you would be willing to appear on the radio July 1 or at some time during the week of June 25 on behalf of the Cadet Nurse Corps. I believe that a message from you would mean a great deal to Cadet Nurses and to the gallant group of graduate nurses who are responsible for their education and service during this critical war period. The schedule of broadcasts which will carry these messages is not yet complete, but originating points will be New York City, Chicago, Hollywood, and possibly San Francisco. If you are to be in or near any one of these cities, and would be available for a personal appearance, I should very much appreciate hearing from you as soon as possible, so that we may make up our schedule in cooperation with the Office of War Information who is arranging facilities.

May I thank you in advance for your assistance in this matter, and say again how happy we should be to have you as one of our guests of honor.
