

- A. Stage should be a minimum of 20 feet deep, 30 feet wide, and 4 feet high.
- B. Purchaser shall provide a drum riser that is 8 feet by 8 feet by 18 inches high.
- 2. STAGEHANDS
 - A. Three stagehands must be present at load-in and load-out.
- 3. POWER
 - A. Single phase 40 amp, 110 volts
- 4. DRESSING ROOMS
- A. One clean, well lit, lockable dressing room large enough to comfortably accommodate 10 people is required.
