- 9. Employer shall have reasonable supervision over the services of the Performers during the herein Engagement, & the Performers, through their agent, expressly agree to cooperate & consult with the Employer within the terms of this agreement to cause Engagement to be fulfilled in a good workman-ship-like manner & to help Employer accomplish the ends & purposes contemplated between the parties. The Agent for DEMENTIA agrees too, that they shall cause the contract to be fulfilled at the indicated time & place.
