

A NEW HOME FOR KMOJ RADIO

In early 1983, KMOJ Radio will be moving into newly renovated facilities at 501 Bryant Avenue north in Minneapolis. This building is being provided by the Minneapolis Community Development Agency. The new facilities will feature three FM studios for broadcast and production, a news production studio and an AM studio for training. The AM studio can be converted into a video/cable control room. KMOJ will also be wired into a new theatre being built in the new Glenwood Community Center, adjacent to the building in which the radio station will be housed. The inter-connection with the theatre will enable KMOJ to broadcast live drama and other events originating from the theatre.

KMOJ has an application pending with the Federal Communications Commission for a power increase and will be included as one of the FM services on the Minneapolis and other area cable TV-systems as well. With the anticipated number of people who will benefit from the cable hookups and the power increase, KMOJ can expect its coverage area to increase tremendously, and the number of people being served to jump from the current extimated 50,000 to more than 1.2 million.

The Minneapolis Community Development Agency and the Department of Housing and Urban Development will be rehabilitating the housing units in the North Minneapolis Public Housing Community. The current facilities of KMOJ are actually two converted apartment units, which are slated for rehabilitation. This means that KMOJ will have to move. Because of the vital service that KMOJ provides to the community, the Resident Councils of the Glenwood/Lyndale-Sumner/Olson Communities saw to it that the new facilities would be provided for the station through MCDA and HUD. The move will be a positive step in KMOJ's continuing development.

What's needed now is funding to equip the new facilities. Many sources of funding, particularly from the federal government, have disappeared due to the budget cuts. Although KMOJ has never received much federal support in the past, the future looks even bleaker in terms of funding from the federal level. Therefore, KMOJ will have to make the private sector and listener/supporters its main focus when seeking monies for operation and capital improvement.

We can no longer take things for granted. Things don't just happen, we make them happen. KMOJ is counting on you, for your support.
