RIDER FOR MISSION OF BURMA

THIS RIDER IS ATTACHED TO AND MADE PART OF THE CONTRACT DATED

ACCES 5 82 BY AND BETWEEN MISSION OF BURMA (HEREIN

REFERRED TO AS "ARTIST") AND Steve McClellon Front and

(HEREIN REFERRED TO AS EMPLOYER).

 Artist shall receive one hundred percent (100%) star billing in all advertising, displays, program and any and all other advertising and publicity. Billing shall read:

MISSION OF BURMA (100%)

- 2. Artist's fee shall be made payable to MISSION OF BURMA, in CASH or CERTIFIED CHECK ONLY.
- measured in whole or in part by a percentage of receipts, Artist shall have the right to set a limit to the number of free admissions authorized by EMPLOYER. If the employer is unable to accurately determine the number of persons admitted free, the Employer agrees to accept as binding a reasonable estimate made by the Artist's representative. Further, Employer agrees that at no time will the number of free admissions, i.e. house guests, employee guests and press to be in excess of <a href="https://www.people.com/www.people.co
- 4. Employer agrees to provide a comfortable and private dressing room adequate for the use of SIX (6) persons during Artist's entire performance. This room shall be clean, dry, well lit, heated or air conditioned, shall have mirrors and contain at least SIX (6) chairs or comfortable seating for SIX (6) persons.
- 5. Employer shall be solely responsible for the security of items in the dressing room area and shall keep all unauthorized persons from entering said area.
- 6. Artist shall have the right to approve any other acts on the program. Artist shall also have approval of their billing and order of performance. Should any support act exceed its contracted set length, Artist shall perform its full set and Employer shall be solely responsible for any overtime charges as a result.

7. SOUND EQUIPMENT: If Employer is providing P.A., it shall meet the following minimum requirements:

House mixing console: at least (16) inputs, each with the following: at least (3) bands of equalization; at least (4) submaster assignments; at least (2) post fader echo sends; solo assignment to headphones.

House electronics: at least (1) one-third octave graphic equalizer and (1) limiter/compressor on console output.

Monitor speakers: Three identical floor monitors needed.

House speakers and amps: adequate to cover venue and of professional quality.

Microphones: three (3) professional vocal microphones; eight (8) additional microphones for insturments.

Microphone stands: total of eleven (11) stands; nine of these should be boom stands, and two straight stands.

Direct box: one (1) needed for Bass.

Effects: Space echo or Digital Delay unit.

- 8. <u>LIGHTING EQUIPMENT</u>: If employer is providing stage lighting it shall meet the following requirements:

 <u>Front wash</u>: three (3) fresnels.

 <u>Side wash</u>: total of four(4); two (2) per side.

 <u>Front pin spots</u>: total of three (3).
- 9. Employer will provide Artist (including all sidepeople) with:
 One (1) case of imported beer on ice
 - Two (2) quarts of orange juice
 - Two (2) large bottles of Cola
 - Two (2) large bottles of mineral water

Deli tray consisting of: assorted meats and cheeses, fruit, assorted light and dark breads, condiments and silverware.

This deli tray should be large enough to accommodate SIX (6).

- 10. There will be absolutely no tape recordings, video recording, radio broadcasts during the performance unless prior written permission is granted by Artist or his representative.
- 11. Employer must be at the concert hall or club TWO hours before the doors open and remain until all requirements of the Contract and Rider are fulfilled.

- 12. In case of any conflict of terms, the terms contained in this Rider shall prevail over any other. All terms of this Rider are specifically accepted by Employer unless they are waived by the Artist. Such waiver shall be effective only if initialed by both Artist and Employer.
- 13. Employer agrees to attach equipment Rider if any.


