Technical And Hospitality Requirements

SET UP

Band needs a minimum of 5 hours prior to starting time for load in, set up, and sound check, without an audience. Any questions upon arrival should be directed to the road manager only.

STAGING/POWER

Band requests a minimum stage size of 12 feet deep and 36 feet wide but will be flexible dependent on size and nature of event. Power must be located centrally on stage with no less than eight (8) double AC outlets that provide uninterrupted power that is adequately grounded.

DRESSING/HOSPITALITY

Dressing room must be clean and located close to stage area and restrooms, but separate from area of performance. It must accommodate 10 people with 10 chairs, 1 large mirror, and be lockable. Key must be made available to road manager upon arrival. Band requests one gallon of natural orange juice, one gallon pineapple juice, one gallon fresh water, 1 bottle German white wine and 1 case naturally brewed beer. All food should be only vegetarian and include a variety of peaches, bananas, avocados, red apples, natural rentless cheeses, crackers and whole wheat bread.

SOUND

In some situations, band may travel with sound technician and sound system sufficient to handle capacities up to 400 persons. If more than 400 persons are expected, it will be necessary to supplement existing system accordingly. To assure a successful concert, the minimum requirements listed below are your guide if you are contracted to provide sound reinforcement and/or lighting. These requirements will need to be supplemented if concert is to be held outdoors, and specifics should be discussed well in advance.

16 channel mixing board (preferably Peavey, BI-Amp or Kelsey), with minimum 1 monitor send and 1 effects send per channel (preferably 2 per channel), can be mono or stereo;

18 microphones minimum (preferably 14 Shure SM57's and 4 Shure SM58's), 18 microphone stands with clips and booms for 17 and 1 goose neck;

1 KORG stage echo, 1 reverb unit, 1 2-channel graphic equalizer with 15 bands per channel (preferably MXR or DOD), 1 1-channel graphic equalizer with 30 bands per channel (preferably MXR or DOD);

Main speakers: minimum 2 90° horns with 45–70 watt drivers (preferably JBL), 2 mid-range cabinets with 12" speakers (preferably JBL), 2 bass cabinets with 15" speakers (preferably JBL), 3 way active crossover and adequate amplification power to drive said system (preferably Peavey, BGW, or Crown);

4 10" or 12" monitor speakers (preferably JBL) with 800 watts RMS of amplification (preferably Peavey, BGW, or Crown).

LIGHTING

Band requires lighting adequate for existing stage area, capable of individual emphasis on each member (5), multi-colored gels and one spot light (optional dependent on size of room). If personnel is necessary to operate lighting equipment, it will be supplied by employer and directed by band.

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
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
