

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Chelsea sprang from the beginnings of the British punk movement during the summer of 1976 - the same beginnings that spawned the Sex Pistols, Damned, Clash, and Buzzcocks. Fronted by the "perpetual showman" Gene October, the original band also consisted of Billy Idol, Tony James, and John Towe. The latter three soon parted company to form Generation X; Gene regrouped his forces and moved onward and upward.

The "new" Chelsea recorded their first of nine U.K. singles, "Right To Work," in early 1977. This was followed by immumerous tours of Britain, two U.S. tours, two U.K. albums, and an appearance in the American motion picture Urgh: A Music War.

Chelsea also underwent a series of personnel changes, as the assorted players would leave the group for more "light-weight" bands. October would continue to recruit new replacements quickly though, and again Chelsea would be back on the road or in the recording studio.

Finally, in the fall of 1981, the tide began to turn in the band's favor. After years of lukewarm responses from the British press, reviews heated up significantly with the release of "Evacuate" then "War Across the Nation," Chelsea's eighth and ninth U.K. singles. This, coupled with their appearance at the Leeds Christmas On Earth festival with the Damned, Anti-Nowhere League, and Exploited (Chelsea stole the show), firmly thrust the group before the U.K. limelight to bask at long last!
