

BODY MUSIC MOKILI: Body Music c/w Motema/Body Music Island (12)WIP 6822

Body Music Mokili is Jah Wobble and Ben Mandelson, together with friends and associates. Wobble, of course, is the bassist formerly with Public Image. Over the past year he has been making records in collaboration with members of Can as well as fronting his own band, Human Condition. Ben Mandelson is the guitarist with the acclaimed Afro band, Orchestre Jazira, although he first came to notice as a member of Magazine. In addition Mandelson contributed sleeve notes to Island's African compilations, Sound d'Afrique Volumes One and Two: Mandelson has been an avid collector of African pop music since the early-Seventies.

JAH WOBBLE, A BRIEF...

After brief. uninspiring stints as a cab driver and road manager for Johnny Thunders, John Wardell, Tottenham football supporter and friend of former Sex Fistol John Lydon, was invited to join Lydon's new musical enterprise, Public Image Ltd. as bass player.

After leaving PIL for the usual "musical reasons", the ambitious John W.-having assumed the moniker Jah Wobble- started a solo career writing songs and playing bass which resulted in his 1980 Virgin LP "The Legend Lives On... Jah Wobble". The European press was not overly enthusiastic about the album, but neither had they been about the first two Sex Pistols singles nor the two Virgin Wobble singles. On both those singles Wobble takes the piss out of over-exposed, trite reggae material. It was hip stuff for the in-crowd, but tongue-in-cheek for 'Jah', as evidenced by the send-up artwork on the sleeves. Those 12-inch covers were designed by Dennis Morris, PIL/Virgin house designer and photographer (Island as well), and later on singer for the cult band Basement Five.

Wobble's humourous criticism of record companies reveals a healthy dose of paranoia towards the music business in general. At the same time, it is probably the reason for his own releases being so randomly available through haphazard distribution. For example, prior to the encore at a rare show at London's Collegiate Theatre, his band The Human Condition announced that the show that evening would be available on cassette the next day outside the hall sol: by the band themselves. They sold over 2000 bad quality cassettes of the show, tapes that had no identification on them whatsoever.

The Human Condition presented an unexpected farewell show at Paul Raymond's famous former sex theatre in Soho. The show was a sellout, but the last one of its kind, thusly ending Wobble's period of non-vocal, post-PIL new wave jazz. It also marked the split-up with drummer Jim Walker, another PIL graduate.

Wobble is now working on new material which concentrates on what he likes to call 'Islam Funk'. The band he works with now are called "Invaders of the Heart" and consists of Wobble (on bass), trombone, percussion, "goitar, synth/keyboards, and drums.

Current Wobble releases are his four-track "Bedroom Album" and an October '8. Island Records 12-inch called "Body Music Mokili" A proper studio album with Invaders of the Heart is in the works as well as a single, both to be distributed and manufactured by Rough Trade Records Ltd.

1. This Rider forms an integral part of the agreement thus being legal and binding to both parties. Any agreement returned with the Rider unattched, unsigned, or altered without prior consent from Artist will be deemed null and void. This will be considered reason for immediate cancellation.

BILLING

When headlining, Non Wobble shall receive One Hundred Percent Sole Star Billing on all advertising and publicity pertaining to the engagement. No other act shall receive billing in equal size or prominence without Artist's prior consent. When not headlining, Artist shall receive One Hundred Percent Special Guest Star Billing in all forms of advertising and publicity pertaining to the engagement. In either case, if their is a marquee, Jahwobble must appear.

3. LOAD-IN AND SOUNDCHECK

Management shall provide access to venue a minimum of 3 hours prior to the doors opening to the public. Parking shall be provided for Artist's vehicles in close proximity to the stage area at this time. All persons connected with the presentation of the concert, and all sound, lighting, and stage equipment shall be operational at this time as well.

Soundcheck shall last a minimum of 2 hours, not including load-in, set up, and break down time. THE SOUND CHECK IS VITAL. IF AN ADEQUATE SOUND CHECK IS NOT PROVIDED FOR, ARTIST RESERVES THE RIGHT, WITHOUT ANY LIABILITY, TO TERMINATE THIS CONTRACT AND CANCEL THE PERFORMANCE AND THE MANAGEMENT SHALL BE OBLIGATED TO PAY FULL CONTRACT PRICE TO THE ARTIST.

4. ALL SOUND AND LIGHTING EXPENSES, AS WELL AS ANY ADDITIONAL PRODUCTION EXPENSES SHALL BE PAID IN FULL BY MANAGEMENT, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:

Talkback microphone to stage and P.A.
P.A. echo system
Cassette player
22 microphones and 22 proper type (boom, short, straight) stands
Five direct input boxes
Monitor system consisting of:

Stage shall be a minimum of 40 feet from left to right, 27 the F.A.

Feet deep and three feet high, with seperate wings for the F.A.

and a minimum overhead clearance of ten feet.

A qualified electriction shall be available from one hour after load-in is scheduled until sound check is completed, also during stage call.

The stage shall be cleared of any risers.

A minimum of 90 amps stage power, 30 amps stage right, 30 amps stage left, and 30 amps center stage. A minimum of 120 amps power shall be provided for Artist's lighting. Any personal injury due to improper grounding or power problems shall be the sole liability of the Management.

In the event that suitable power is not available and a portable generator is to be wmployed, the Management will be responsible for any damage which may result from the faulty operation of said generator.

The Artist shall have the exclusive right of approval on the sound lighting system to be provided by the Management. Manager and/or road manager of Atrist must be informed well in advance of date of performance on specifications of sound and lighting systems to be provided. If for any reason this is not done or any changes are made without Artist's consent, Artist reserves the right to cancel without any further obligation to promoter. WHEN NOT HEADLINING, ARTIST SHALL BE GUARANTEED EQUAL USE OF ENTIRE SOUND ANDLIGHTING SYSTEM PROVIDED FOR THE HEADLINE ATTRACTION.

DRESSING ROOMS

Management agrees to provide one room for use by the Artist for tuning, testing equipment, etc. This room must have a minimum of two AC power outlets and must be pleasant and clean. Also, one additional ONLY ONE room for the exclusive use of the Artist which must be pleasant and clean and have at least two AC power outlets, 10 chairs, one table, and a closet with hangers or several clothing hooks. All rooms described MUST BE LOCKABLE. Keys to said rooms must be delivered to Artist's road manager upon arrival to venue on day of performance. Security guard must be posted at said rooms during sound check and stage call if said rooms are not lockable. All rooms must have adequate heating and/or air conditioning and elean lavatory facilities within or in elese proximity to said rooms. Management agrees to ensure that no persons other than those approved by Artist's road manager will be allowed at any time back stage, on stage or in the backstage area. No backstage passes may be issued without Artist's tour manager's approval.

6. DEPOSTIS, GUARANTEES, ETC.

Artist reserves the right to cancel siad engagement if deposit as stated on face of contract to which this rider is attached is not received by AAM on or before date agreed upon in said contract. Management agrees that in the case of Artist being paid a percentage of the doors gross receipts, the Artist's representative must be allowed to inspect all ticket stubs (or whatever system the Management uses in determining the gross door receipts) during and after performance.

The specific capacity, gross potential , and ticket price breakdown of the facility where Artist is to perform under this agreement must be printed on the face of the contract to which this rider is

If, when headlining, the terms of this agreement do not include a percentage participation by the Artist, it is understood and agreed that said non-participation is predicated on that admission price (or potential gross as stated on the face of contract) must be a condition of contract and adhered to. In the event that the price of admission and/or the gross box office receipts exceed those stipulated in the contract, the Management must pay the Artist the total difference between agreed upon potential gross and actual gross. In any event, all monies owed to Artist by Management as agreed upon in attached contract must be paid to Artist immediately . following Artist's performance.

MERCHANDISING

T-shirts, programs, buttons, or souvenirs of any kind dearing Artist's name or likeness shall not be sold at the show without prior written consent from Artist. Artist shall have the right to supervise the selling of such merchandise and be provided true receipts and inventories of such sales.

LIVE RECORDINGS

Management shall not permit audio or video recording or filming of Artist's performance and will assume full legal and financial responsibility for such activity. Absolutely no recordings or filming without prior wrtifen consent from Artist. No tape recorders shall be allowed on the premises where the show is being held.

REFRESHMENTS

The following shall be supplied by Management at Management's own expense:

Fresh fruits and cold cuts One gallon bottled fresh water

Two (2) bottles fruit juice (orange or grapefruit)

At time of load-in, Artists crew shall be supplied with soft drinks,

Fifteen minutes prior to stage call, Artist's road manager will be supplied with six (6) additional beers and six (6) additional glasses of water to be delivered to the stage.

10. TAX

If there is any assessment of tax by any taxing authority on the Artist for monies earned during the performance said taxes shall be paid by the Management and it is fully understood and agreed that no deductions whatenever in respect to such taxes shall be taken from the price contained herin or in any percentage earned 8% SALES TAX PRIOR

PERMITS, VISAS, CLEARANCES

Management shall provide at its sole expense, all necessary permits, licenses, immigration clearances, bonds, and authorization that may be necessary if concert is to be held outside the U.S.A.

12. FORCE MAJEURE

If any member of Jah Woods shall become ill or incapacitated, Artist shall not be required to perform the engagement, in which instance neither party to this agreement including the Artist shall be under any obligation to each other for any further performance. In the event of civil disorder, an act of God, or the like which could lead to damage to life or property to the Artist, the Artist, in their judgement, has the right to cancel this contract without liability.
