

Sarah has made satisfying progress in nursery school this year. Her motor coordination is good, as can be noticed in her ease and poise in walking, running and climbing. Although she enjoys being outdoors, and uses the play apparatus well, she is not too vigorously active. Her interests are centered chiefly in work materials.

The fine muscles of her fingers are well developed as shown by the skill with which she uses paint, blocks, clay and wood. Painting is preferred to all other activities. Her work habits are particularly well developed. Whatever she is doing at any time is well planned and well executed. She works with a definite purpose in mind, usually shunning suggestions from children and adults. She shows persistence, drive, and determination.

Sarah is inclined to be a little too reserved. She smiles frequently when something pleases her, but is generally a sober, serious little girl. She is quick to retaliate over the slightest bump or accident, and rarely sees there may be a funny side to the situation. Developing an ability to see the lighter side of things would release tensi n and help her appreciate amusing incidents in a more enjoyable manner. Upon meeting or position, she may flare into a brief temper outburst, and perhaps sulk for a few minutes following the occasion. She is beginning to accept suggestions and helpful criticism, and is gradually becoming a "better sport".

Sarah is friendly but not af ectionate toward others. She prefers playing with only a few of the chaldren, chiefly because particular interests seem to be mutual and agreeable. Housekeeping activities and dramatic play are preferred. Her play exhibits original and practical ideas, but very little of the imaginative.

Music holds great appeal. In rhythms she loses her self-conscious attitude and expresses herself freely and easily. She is willing to participate and offers interpretations of her own which are creative and delightful.

She enjoys listening to stories. Frequently she participates in simple dramatizations. She does not contribute stories of her own, however, and has little to offer in an audience situation.

Sarah should made a better social adjustment next year. The activities of the Kindergarten will require more social organization, and will be a definite challenge to Sarah in identifying herself with a group.
