Three of your most interesting and enjoyable letter have reached us and it is a great satisfaction to learn how much historic and other fine information you are gathering from many of the notible sights that have given England, Scotland and Ireland such a historic past and made the production of its historians, poets, novelists and dramatists so far outstanding beyond what other countries have produed, with the exception, perhaps, of instrumental music and perhaps oter things that could be attributed to its enjoyment by voice, etc. went over some of the points that you visited in Scotland and partly in Ireland, and it gave even a greater appreciation to your letters than we could hav: sotten out of the description of places that we haven't seen. ** the this letter will reach you in Stockholm, if not on the 23rd., that it will be there on the 26th. when you return from the side-trip that you are making from Stockholm.
