MADISON It was announced today that Senator Hubert Humphrey will address members of the Milwaukee County Democratic Party at a breakfast Saturday morning, September 26. The breakfast, which begins at 8:00 A. M. will be held at the Eagles Club in Milwaukee.

Humphrey, a leading Democratic hopeful for the 1960 Presidential nomination, will then depart for Green Bay where he is scheduled to speak at a noon luncheon at the Northland Hotel. The Minnesota Senator will campaign extensively throughout Wisconsin for five days. It is expected that Humphrey will enter Wisconsin's Presidential Primary which will be held April 5.

Mrs. Humphrey, Lt. Gov. Karl Rolvaag, and Sam Rizzo, Chairman of the Wisconsin Humphrey for President Committee will accompany Senator Humphrey on his Wisconsin tour.
