I have checked with Frank Stanley, President of NNPA, Louie Martin, and Bill Welsh, and the consensus is that you should discuss briefly the following items:

1. Need for active support of President's civil rights legislation. ✓
 - A. Negro press must galvanize local political and community support for passage of civil rights legislation. ✓
2. *Viet* Emphasize the Administration's desire for peace in Viet Nam, and that our responsibility there has and will not result in a cutback in our domestic responsibility vis a vis the War on Poverty and other programs to rehabilitate slums and improve the quality of life of the disadvantaged. |
3. Importance of providing local leadership in voter registration efforts.

It is suggested that following your brief remarks, the rest of the time be spent discussing the concerns of the publishers.
