1 ADDRESS OF HUBERT H. HUMPHREY  
2 VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES

4 VICE-PRESIDENT HUMPHREY: May I thank you, Senator  
5 Dymally, and my good friend, Senator Billy Greene. Thank  
6 you for holding the fort while we were getting here.

7 May I express my good wishes to Councilman  
8 Lindsay, and Billy Mills. Will you stand up, please.  
9 City Councilman Lionel Cade of Compton; Councilman Douglas  
10 Dollarhide; Doris Davis, Compton City Clerk; and I  
11 wouldn't want to overlook our State Chairman, Assemblyman  
12 Charles Warren, who is here with us tonight, and all of those  
13 who have come here tonight for this Voter Registration  
14 Rally.

15 I have had a wonderful visit today with, first,  
16 Billy Greene, who has toured the south part of Los Angeles  
17 with me, and Senator Dymally, who has been up to the State  
18 Capitol and getting legislature passed, which you have  
19 wanted for a long time.

20 (Applause)

21 The Senator has told me that today he would be  
22 able to get through his quality education program, so we  
23 will start to get the finest schools and the best teachers  
24 that it is possible to get.

25 (Applause)

26 I want to tell you one other thing, you have one

1 of the finest Congressmen that ever came to Washington,  
2 and that is Gus Hawkins.

3 I don't know what happened to our young folks  
4 down here in front, but I know that some of them have some  
5 idea here about Head Start. I want them to know that Hubert  
6 Humphrey has had something to do with this Head Start, from  
7 the beginning, and we will keep it in OEO.

8 Just a few words to you about this Registration  
9 Rally. We have found that in order to get voters for this  
10 election, we have to have voter registration, and it is  
11 to be done right out here, and I want the voter registration  
12 to be done by you among yourselves. I don't want to have  
13 anybody going up to City Hall to get it done. I want you  
14 to do it out here where you live, and do it with your own  
15 people, so let's get behind Senator Dymally and Billy  
16 Greene to get that job done.

17 (Applause)

18 Ladies and gentlemen, we can be very complacent.  
19 We have got to quit fooling around with this country and  
20 get on with the problems and things that need to be done.  
21 That job that needs to be done is jobs, right out here,  
22 and right now, and above all, we need to have this -- my  
23 friends -- now, my friends --
