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GOP SOUGHT TO BUY RATHER THAN EARN TRUST OF AMERICAN PEOPLE, HUMPHREY SAYS

Youngstown, Ohio--Vice President Hubert H. Humphrey said today that the Republicans "have tried to buy what can only be earned--the trust of the American people."

The Nixon-Agnew Campaign will set a new all-time record of campaign spending, up sharply from earlier record levels.

"They have failed, because the American voters are not just so many clicks in the Republican computer. They are mothers and fathers, people with elderly parents they care for, people with children in school."

"Just ask yourself," Humphrey said, "what life would be like in Youngstown today if Jack Kennedy had not beaten Richard Nixon in 1960.

"Your mother and father would have no medicare, and a lot less social security. They might be waiting for charity or more help from you--and ashamed of it.

"Richard Nixon cast the tie-breaking vote against Federal aid to education in 1960, so I doubt if your youngsters would have the benefits of it today.

"There are 35,000 young Ohioans in college this fall--your kids--with Federal loans and scholarships. They probably wouldn't be there if the Republicans had had their way with aid to higher education."

"And what about your job? The Republicans produced three job-killing recessions in the 1950's," Humphrey said.

Humphrey also emphasized the need to slow, not accelerate as Nixon proposes, the dangerous, costly strategic arms race.

Make no mistake about it: If the Republicans get into the White House, you are going to have more unemployment. They have said so. They are actually committed, as a matter of Republican policy, to deliberately throwing men out of work.

It is no longer a question of whether there will be a recession if the Republicans get in. It's only a question of how long it will last and how deep it will cut.

I pledge this to every family in America: We will have full employment and economic growth in the Humphrey-Muskie Administration ... and you can count on it.

I also pledge this: The Humphrey-Muskie Administration will halt the rise in the cost of living -- and we'll reform the tax structure so no family pays more than its fair share.

But we need not -- and we will not -- sacrifice prosperity on the altar of outdated Republican economics.

I want to say a special word to the ladies in the audience -- not only as mothers and shoppers and homemakers -- but as individuals.

In 1963 I sponsored an amendment to the Constitution to assure equal rights for women. We must now push forward to achieve these objectives.

I helped pass legislation which prohibits discrimination in employment on the basis of sex.
