THEY ARE FACED EACH DAY WITH BILLS THEY CAN'T PAY AND TAXES

THEY CAN'T AFFORD.

AMERICANS ARE FED UP WITH A SYSTEM THAT ALLOWS A PRIVILEGED FEW TO REAP VAST BENEFITS AT THE EXPENSE OF WORKING AMERICANS.

I PLEDGE TO THE PEOPLE OF WEST VIRGINIA THAT I WILL END THE INJUSTICE AND UNFAIRNESS OF AN ADMINISTRATION WHICH SACRIFICES JOBS TO FIGHT INFLATION.
