Madame Chairman, Distinguished Guests, Ladies and Gentlemen of the Gridiron Club.

I was just introduced as the titular leader of the Democratic

Party. I don't know whether any pun was intended by that introduction

given the circumstances surrounding this meeting, I am frequently

introduced with the word "titular", but somehow this evening it seems

of special significance, Gould it be that the introduction was designed

to remind you that the Democrats have split into so many fractions that

we will be known as the Raquel Welch Party — because of our cleavage.

In any event, I feel tonight like Hubert Horato Hamlet:

"To be here or not to be here; that was my question

Whether twould be nobler in the mind to suffer slings and arrows of the picket line outside

Or take arms against the sea of troubles  $\underline{\text{inside}}$ , and, by opposing, end them."

You can see that I am here, in character, determined to work

within the system. You and I know that significant social change
requires activities from both marchers and talkers. Some people use
their feet and some people use their mouths. It therefore must be

no surprise to you to find me here and not on the picket line outside walking.

For I long ago established the category to which I belong.

But more of that later. Let us therefore get on with the serious business of the day -- politics.

At the outset, I went to express my appreciation at your invitation to have me speak to you this evening. This is indeed an honor I did not deserve, but then again I lost the last election, and I didn't deserve that either

Heckler speak. Here are two distinguished members of Congress. The fact that you would have them grace your dais this evening is a tribute to you and your club. W. C. Fields was once asked whether he favored clubs for women. His classic answer was: "Sure I do when all other means of persuasion fail." But it was politics I wanted to talk to you about tonight, and so I want to pay special tribute to my good friend, Barry Goldwater, who shares this platform with me. We and I began this routine a number of years ago at another club. It was, if I remember — you should excuse the expression — the Womens Press Club. As I evaluate his administration, I want to be objective about it.
