The audience will be 3/4 Black, 1/4 White. Max suggested that we use the Columbus Speech on the Nixon record and add information about how the Black population has been adversely affected by Nixon's policies.

I talked with Joe Reed, and he liked this theme.

He wants you to "touch the folks." He said that the biggest issue in the Black community is jobs -- "Black folks want some jobs that will provide a decent living.

On the busing issue -- he says do not use the words "racial balance." This is not a question down there. The question is quality education and busing kids from poor schools to good ones. He said that no one wants kids bused from good schools to poor ones.

WHAT'S THE MAIN ISSUE IN 1972?

ADMINISTRATION AND THE ABSENCE OF FAIRNESS IN AMERICAN SOCIETY -- AND THE PRESENCE OF BITTERNESS, DESPAIR, AND DIVISION.

IT'S DEEN RICHARD NIXON'S WHITE HOUSE FOR 39 MONTHS
AND THE ECONOMY IS IN DEEP TROUBLE.

AND POOR, YOUNG AND OLD.

IT'S BEEN RICHARD NIXON'S WHITE HOUSE FOR 39 MONTHS
AND WE ARE STILL AT WAR IN ASIA.

IT'S BEEN RICHARD MIXON'S WHITE HOUSE FOR 39 MONTHS
AND WE'VE HAD TOO MANY PROMISES, TOO MANY PRESS RELEASES,

PERCENT OF BLACK YOUNG AMERICANS WERE UNABLE TO FIND JOBS.

AND THEESS THE ADMINISTRATION ACTS AND ACTS SOON -- WE CAN

IMPORTS UP -- EXPORTS DOWN.

THIS IS THE KEED OF ECONOMIC RECORD THAT SAYS "NO" TO
THE AMERICAN WORKER, THE HOUSENIFE AND BUSINESSMAN.

AND IT SAYS "NO" TO BLACK AMERICANS -- WHOSE INCOME IS ONLY 61 PER CENT THAT OF WHITES, WHO EARN AN AVERAGE OF \$3,600 LESS ACROSS THE BOARD THAN WHITES.

IT'S WRONG THAT THE AMERICAN MORKER IS FORCED TO PAY
WITH HIS JOD FOR THE IMEPT ONE-SIDED, PRO-BIS BUSINESS
ECONOMIC FAILURES OF THIS REPUBLICAN ADMINISTRATION.

WHAT'S THE NIXON RECORD ON DEALING FAIRLY WITH ALL SECTORS OF THE AMERICAN ECONOMY?

AND IT'S THE SAME IN CIVIL RIGHTS, IN VOTING RIGHTS,

IN HOUSING AND IN HEALTH. THE HEALTH CARE CAP BETWEEN

BLACK AND WHITE AMERICA IS CLAPING: THREE BLACKS DIE OF

TUBERCULOSIS FOR EVERY WHITE — FIVE BLACK WOMEN DIE FROM

PREGNANCY COMPLICATIONS FOR EVERY WHITE WOMAN — AND ALMOST

TWO BLACK CHILDREN DIE FOR EVERY WHITE CHILD.

IT'S A RECORD OF UNKEPT PROMISES.

AND IT'S A RECORD OF VETOES.

A NIXON VETO OF BETTER HOSPITALS IN JUNE 1970.

A NIXON VETO OF BETTER EDUCATION IN AUGUST 1970.

A MIXON VETO OF URBAN RENEWAL AND WATER SEWAGE PROJECTS
IN AUGUST 1970.

A MIXON VETO OF A PROGRAM TO GIVE US MORE DOCTORS IN JANUARY 1970.

A WIXEN VETO THAT WOULD GIVE JOBS AND TRAINING TO THE UNEMPLOYED IN DECEMBER 1970.

A NIXON VETO OF AN ACCELERATED PUBLIC WORKS PROGRAM IN JUNE 1978.

A NIXON VETO OF GREATLY NEEDED CHILD CARE -- THE CRUELEST OF THEM ALL IN DECEMBER 1971.

THIS IS THE RECORD OF 39 MONTHS. THIS IS THE RECORD RICHARD NIXON, SPIRO AGNEW AND JOHN MITCHELL MUST DEFEND.

THIS IS THE RECORD THAT THE AMERICAN PEOPLE WILL NOT LET THEM FORGET.

THERE IS MORE THAN A BAD RECORD AT ISSUE TODAY.

AT ISSUE IS A GOVERNMENT NOT GUIDED BY THE PRINCIPLE OF FAIRNESS FOR ALL OF ITS CITIZENS. :

RESOURCES OF THIS MATION TO SOLVE THE NEEDS OF ALL THE

PEOPLE -- A SOCIETY THAT MAKES ALL THE PEOPLE THE BEHEFICIARIES

OF OUR MEALTH AND OUR PESOURCES, NOT THE VICTIMS OF RECESSION

AND HARD TIMES.

I PLEDCE A FAIR SOCIETY THAT BRIDGES THE CREAT DIVISION BETWEEN BLACK AND WHITE IN THIS COUNTRY -- IN JOBS, INCOME, EDUCATION, HEALTH CARE.

RECONCILIATION DETWEEN ALL THE DIVISIONS OF THIS COUNTRY

IS POSSIBLE. IT MUST TAKE PLACE. UNTIL AMERICANS BEGIN

TO RESPECT EACH OTHER WE ARE NOT GOING TO REBUILD THIS

ECOHOMY, MAKE OUR CITIES LIVABLE AGAIN AND PROVIDE EQUAL

OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL AMERICANS.

I'VE PROVED THAT YOUR BATTLE IS MY BATTLE IN A CHARTER
CENTURY OF COMMITMENT AND ACTION TO SECURE THE RIGHTS OF ALL
AMERICANS. AND WHEN I SAY SOMETHING TO YOU -- WHEN I PLEDGE
SOMETHING -- I MEAN IT.

AND I SAY TO YOU, ABOVE ALL, WE CAN'T LOOK BACK. WE CAN'T STAND STILL. THERE IS ONLY ONE WAY TO GO -- AND THAT IS FORWARD.
