RE: SPACE SHUTTLE EVENT -- JUNE 5, 1972

This statement is geared towards jobs and welfare.

It's stress is similar to the Lockheed statement -- with praise not going to the company, but to the workers.

You will be taken around by Charlie Stone. Charlie is one of the guys that bolted Jess Unruh in 1968 and broke part of the California delegation for you. He works at North American Rockwell -- he is kind of the "House Democrat" at the middle management level.

Charlie is the President of the EDICT Foundation--this is the Community Conversion plan that you have been a dues paying member of, since 1968, and a co-sponsor of, in the Senate. You are one of the founding members.

Charlie Stone is the brains behind Senate Bill S 32--of which you are a co-sponsor--the National Science Policy and Priorities Act of 1972. This is a reconversion bill. It just came out of Ted Kennedy's subcommittee and is before the main Labor and Public Welfare Committee. Support is broad for this kind of a conversion plan. It will likely pass this year.

Many of the workers and technicians will be wearing EDICT buttons. These buttons symbolize the desire of many men for the government to help with a meaningful conversion

program. They will probably ask you to wear a button also.

O.K. Go ahead.

Charlie has been helpful to us. He has given us a great deal of data. He fought the management so that you could be scheduled to have an event at the space shuttle (North American Rockwell executives were opposed). And, he has personally raised over \$1,000 for your campaign here in California.

Charlie said that the North American executives will likely try to shepherd you away from some of the workers, so just keep an eye out.

Also, Charlie will put a heavy stress in his introduction presentation not just on the Space Shuttle, but on what the Shuttle means to solving some of the domestic problems here at home.
