MAKE NO MISTAKE ABOUT IT, THE UNITED STATES HAS A SOLEMN COMMIT-

MENT AND OBLIGATION ✓ TO A STRONG AND SECURE ISRAEL IN A PEACEFUL

MIDDLE EAST. THE TWO ARE NOT INCONSISTENT AS SOME WOULD HAVE US

BELIEVE. ✓ IN FACT, A WEAK ISRAEL MEANS THAT ITS NEIGHBORS MAY BE

WILLING TO UNDERMINE THE PEACE OF THE REGION.

CANNOT MEAN.

✓ REAPPRAISAL CANNOT MEAN ANY LESSENING OF AMERICAN SUPPORT

FOR THE STATE OF ISRAEL.

Ingredients for Peace
Palestinian Issue *but not* Profits
(1) non Belligerency -
(2) Guarantees
(3) Secure & Defensible Borders

REAPPRAISAL CANNOT MEAN THAT WE WILL ENTER INTO ANY
AGREEMENT OR NEGOTIATION WHICH WILL ENDANGER THE BASIC SECURITY
OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL.

REAPPRAISAL CANNOT MEAN THAT IN OUR SEARCH FOR PEACE WE
FORGET THAT A ~~lasting~~ *lasting* PEACE CANNOT BE HAD WITHOUT THE RECOGNITION
OF ISRAEL AS A SOVEREIGN NATION BY ITS NEIGHBORS

WE MUST KEEP ALIVE THE STEP-BY-STEP APPROACH BEGUN BY
SECRETARY KISSINGER. HIS LACK OF SUCCESS ON THE SECOND ROUND
DOES NOT MEAN THAT OUR EFFORTS AT MEANINGFUL NEGOTIATION SHOULD
COME TO AN END.

I DON'T BELIEVE THAT INCREASING ISRAEL'S ALREADY GROWING
INSECURITY IS GOING TO MAKE THE PROCESS OF NEGOTIATION ANY EASIER.
(Pressure on Israel)

L ISRAEL NEEDS TO KNOW THAT THIS NATION STRONGLY SUPPORTS IT, IF IT

IS GOING TO MAKE A CONCESSION FOR PEACE. [THE EGYPTIANS AND SYRIANS

MUST KNOW OF OUR RESOLVE IF THEY ARE TO TAKE MEANINGFUL STEPS

TOWARD PEACE. OUR POLICY SHOULD BE ONE OF ASSURANCE -- NOT

INCREASING AN ALLY'S INSECURITY BY REAPPRAISALS.

I AM MAKING SURE THAT THE CONGRESS WILL BE INCLUDED IN THIS

REAPPRAISAL. I HAVE SPOKEN TO BOTH THE PRESIDENT AND THE SECRETARY

OF STATE ABOUT THIS CRITICAL ISSUE.

L AMERICAN FOREIGN POLICY MUST REMAIN DEDICATED TO THE

SUPPORT OF DEMOCRATIC GOVERNMENTS. ISRAEL IS A SMALL, BUT GREAT

DEMOCRACY.
