To all whom it may concern, GREETINGS:

Know ye that, by virtue of the powers and authorities vested in us, we do hereby constitute and appoint our worthy and well-beloved brethren, _____ Worshipful Master, _____ Senior Warden, and _____ Junior Warden, of a Lodge to be called _____ Lodge, No. _____ to be held at _____ or within five miles of same;

And we do further authorize and empower our said trusty and well-beloved brethren to admit and make Free Masons according to the most ancient and honorable custom of the royal craft in all ages and nations throughout the known world, and not contrarywise;

And we do further empower and appoint the said brethren and their successors, to hear and determine all and singularly matters and things relating to the craft within the jurisdiction of the said lodge, with the assistance of the members of the said lodge;

And lastly, we do hereby authorize and empower our said trusty and beloved brethren to install their successors, — being first Duly Elected and Chosen — to whom they shall deliver this warrant and to invest them with all the powers and dignities to their offices respectively belonging: and such successors shall in like manner, from time to time, install their successors, etc.

Such installation to be upon or near ST. JOHN THE EVANGELIST'S DAY, during the continuance of this lodge forever. Provided always, that the said above named brethren, and their successors, pay due respect to this MOST WORSHIPFUL PRINCE HALL GRAND LODGE, and the ordinances thereof, otherwise this warrant to be of no force or effect.
