require a two-thirds majority of all members present and voting to override any decision of a subordinate body.

27. No member shall sign a contract or agreement that will obligate the club without the consent and knowledge of the organization.

28. All members will pay \$2.50 for any replacement key.

29. Check-out time for guests at the Lodge is 3:00 p.m.

30. At no time will a pet be allowed to be unleashed on the Club Property at Spitzer Lake except during hunting and/or training sessions. Any member guilty of violating this regulation shall be subject to Rules 22, 23, and 24 of The Rules Pertaining to the Lodge at Spitzer Lake.

31. There shall be no hunting within the confines of the Twin City Reel and Trigger Club's property at Spitzer Lake, with the exception of migratory waterfowl, when in season. This will preserve the Club's property as a game refuge. Members guilty of violating this regulation shall be subject to the penalties of Rules 22, 23 and 24 of The Rules Pertaining to the Lodge at Spitzer Lake.

32. A member's immediate family shall have the same rights and privileges at Spitzer Lake as a member.

33. During Opening Days, Special Events and Legal Holidays, families are limited to one bedroom.

Dear Member:

A matter which concerns all members of the Twin City Reel and Trigger Club, Inc. is the progress of our organization. Last month's notice stated that the \$100.00 per member obligation would be discussed at the July meeting. At this meeting a program was introduced whereby we could enhance the beauty and increase the value of our lakeshore property. To date this program has met with the approval of most of those members who were at the last meeting and those who have been contacted outside the meeting. It was also decided at that meeting that we would not vote on the proposal until the August meeting. This will give each member ample time to consider all facets of the proposal. It would also give those members who were unable to attend the July meeting a second chance to participate in the discussion before any vote is taken.

Our tentative program calls for everyones support. The reason for the \$100.00 proposal is many fold. Listed below are the objectives to be accomplished by spring, 1962.

1. Pay off the mortgage - \$815.00.
2. Repair the roof on the McGuire house.
3. Partition the McGuire house into five small rooms.
4. A lounge at one end of the McGuire house.
5. Complete kitchen in the lower level of the McGuire house, including running water, shower, chemical lavatory, tile cement floor.
6. Heating unit for fall and winter use.
7. Aluminum boat or boats.
8. Siding on the James house.
9. Fire escape for the James house.

Further improvements and repairs will be made in the future as funds become available.

How will all this be paid for? Each member must contribute from his own pocket. With a membership of approximately fifty men, each man contributing \$100.00 to be paid at the rate of \$10.00 per month, our objectives can be met. Meeting this obligation is no more difficult than paying for any other item purchased on the installment plan.

Each member will have a payment book or card to be punched or stamped at the time of payment. By June 1st, most of this obligation will have been paid.

This program will be voted upon at the August meeting. It is imperative that you be present, to have your questions answered and to vote in favor of this very important project.

The next regular meeting will be held Saturday, August 26 at Local 516, Fisk and Rondo, St. Paul starting at 8:00 P.M. sharp. We expect to see you there.

IT IS UNFAIR TO ASK A BAPTIST TO SAY JUST A FEW WORDS. IT USUALLY TAKES ME ±) TEN MINUTES TO GET WORMED UP. BUT I WILL DO THE BEST I CAN. IT IS SO NICE TO GIVE RECOGNITION WHILE THE RECIPIENT CAN BE PRESENT. GOD HAS BEEN GOOD TO US. IT IS EXPECTED OF A FRATURNITY TO LAST FIFTY YEARS, BUT WHO IN 1926, THOUGHT # OF THE CHARTER MEMBERS WOULD BE HERE TO WITNESS THIS EVENT? JUST STOP FOR A MINUTE AND REFLECT ON WHAT THIS CLUB HAS GONE THRU. THE CRASH OF ±(1929, THE DEPRESSION YEARS OF THE THIRTIES (WHEN A MAN WORKED FOR 15.00 A WEEK), THRU WORLD WAR II, IN THE 40's, THE KOREAN CONFLECT & VIETNAM POLICE ACTION. IT SURVIVED UNDER DEMOCRATE AND REPUBLICAN ADMINIS-TRATIONS. IT EVEN LIVED THRU THE BURN BABY BURN DAYS OF THE 60's. IT SURVIVED.
