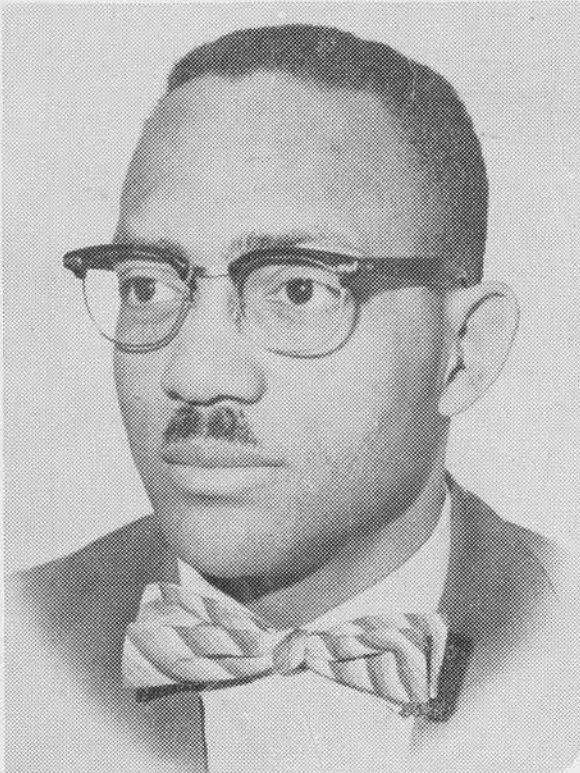

The Twin City Council of Clubs represents an association of individual Twin City clubs. Its primary aims are to coordinate activities and events of its participating clubs; provide assistance and cooperation to the individual club activities; to manifest a united community of sufficient strength to be of collective value in combating social ills that are not in the best interest of its total membership.

The Twin City Council is non-political, non-sectarian, and exerts no jurisdiction over affiliated clubs. Its operation is strictly by and for the clubs it represents. Officers are

elected yearly by representatives of participating clubs. Each club is permitted two voting representatives.

The Council meets once a month, with meetings being held alternately in Minneapolis and St. Paul. Any member of an affiliated club is welcome to attend meetings.

Twin City Clubs not presently affiliated are requested to join and become a part of making our community a more united one — in unity there is strength, direction and purpose.

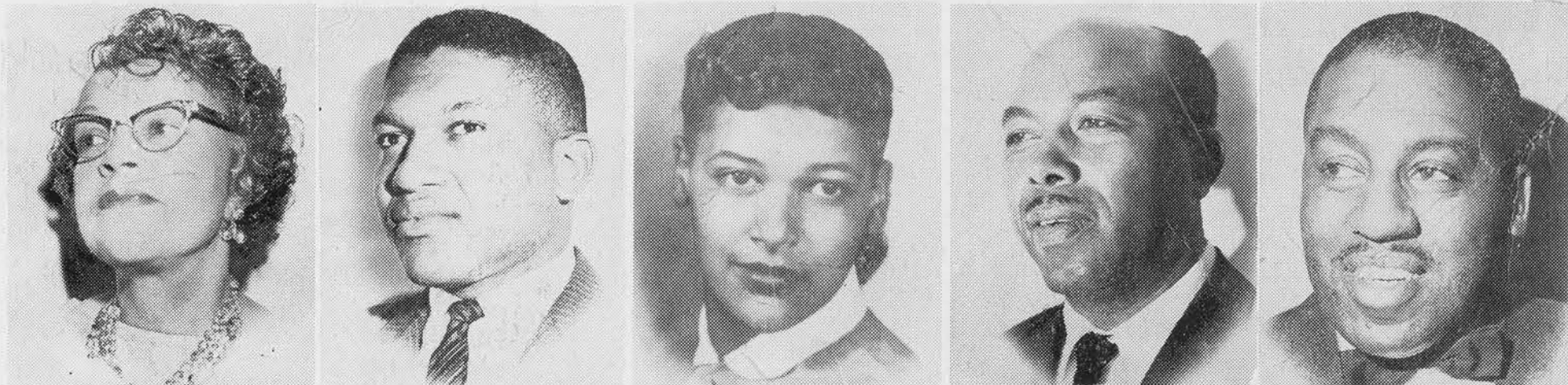
