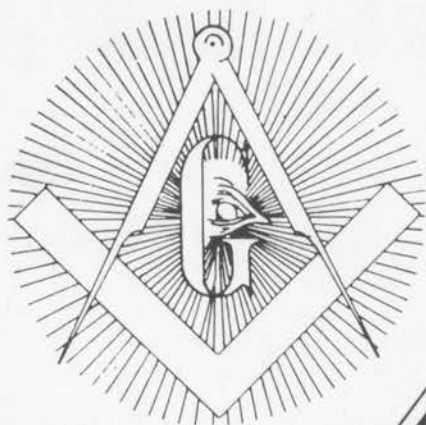

demonstrated its commitment to usful community work; and

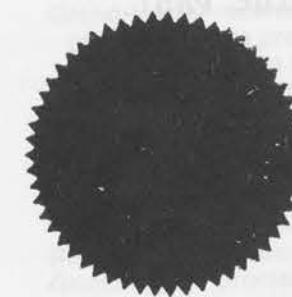
WHEREAS: The Grand Lodge will convene its 88th Annual Convention beginning
