A Sketch of the Early History of Pioneer Lodge

It is apparent that efforts to organize a Masonic Lodge among men of color residing in St. Paul began in the early part of 1866, if not before. The moving spirit in this matter was Brother S. Joseph Farr, North Star Lodge No. 12, Chicago, Illinois jurisdiction of Ohio.

The first gathering was held in Andrews' Barber Shop on Third Street, between Cedar and Minnesota Streets. This meeting was called by Brother Farr, and arrangements were finally made with the new jurisdiction of Missouri for a dispensation that begin the nearest Grand Lodge, as well as the easiest one to reach. Steamboats were at that time the best method of travel, and both St. Paul and St. Louis, the home of the Grand Master of Missouri, were river towns.

A Dispensation having been granted by M. W. Grand Master H. McGee Alexander, Grand Lecturer Moses Dickson, Hannibal, Mo., came to St. Paul and established "Pioneer Lodge U. D." August 4, 1866. The Lodge was formally organized in an office building at Third and Market Streets.

The officers and members were: S. Joseph Farr, W.M.; William A. Griffin, S.W.; Israel Crosby, J.W.; Edmund James, Treasurer; Thomas Jackson, Secretary; Robert Brice, S.D.; David Edwards, J.D.; George B. Williams, S.S.; Frank Crawford, J.S.; Henry Hawkins, Tyler; and Lewis Pierson. Total membership, 11.

At a "Special Communication" of the Grand Lodge of Missouri, December 20-21,-22, 1866, a Warrant was granted to Pioneer Lodge, and No. 5 was assigned. The Committee on Dispensation reported on the 21st, recommended a Warrant, which was approved, and Brother Moses Disckson was recognized as the (proxy) representative of Pioneer Lodge. S. Joseph Farr was appointed District Deputy Grand Master. The officers of the U.D. Lodge became the Charter Officers.

Although Pioneer did not report a roster of officers and members to the "First Annual" Communication of the Grand Lodge, the following December, this item appears in the printed record, "Received of Pioneer Lodge, June 8th, \$50.00 for Warrant."

Early in 1885 the Missouri charter was surrendered. On Friday, May 29, 1885, Pioneer received a charter from African Grand Lodge of Iowa and was numbered 12. With this number, Pioneer continued its progressive existence until the formation of the Grand Lodge of Minnesota.
