PGM Doty, to me as present Grand Master falls the honor of presenting you, as a token, from the M.W.P.H.G.L. of Minn. & Jurisdiction, a beautiful P.G.Master's apron.

Many years ago you were presented upon your induction into the Masonic Fraternity, white lambskin apron. It was the first gift you received as a Mason. It was simply a badge or symbol of your profession as a Freemason and a token of your connection to the Fraternity.

You know full well its esteemed significance, symbolism, and esoteric implications. Its valuable lessons were impressed upon you at that time. There is no symbol of Speculative Masonry more important in its teachings, or more interesting in its history than the white apron of a Mason.

Whatever was to be your future advancement in the organization, into whatever deeper arcana your devotion and thirst for knowledge in this Mystic Institution might have led you, from your first investiture of your apron, you have never parted.

Later in your Masonic life, the Scriptural message: was fulfilled, "You have fought a good fight; you have kept the faith; you have run your course"
You have been faithful over a few things, now I shall make you Ruler over many." Your fellows and brothers elevated you to high office. Upon your brow rested the laurel leaves of victory; upon your breast hung the jewels of success and achievment; upon your broad shoulders was draped the honored purple of our Fraternity.

You wore these vestments of authority well during your terms of office as the tender tributes of correspondence read here tonight have so aptly depicted and as the plaudits of your friends and brothers have manifested.

Yet, never again, until your enfranchised spirit shall have passed upward and inward through the

pearly gates of that land not made with hands eternal in the Heavens, shall any honor so distinguished and so meaningful be bestowed upon you, as this one which I now confer.

I find myself, as Grand Master of the Prince Hall Masons of Minnesota, the descendant of a line of twenty four distinguished, illustrious Grand Masters, including yourself. All of you, deceased or living, bequeath me and all of the brothers of the Craft, a light to be held ever high, as a challenge to the best that is within us. True, all of you made mistakes, at times pondered over what course to take, gained enemies, but on the whole you served so faithfully and well that tonight we honor you and all of those men who have presided in the Grand East before you.

And as I present this apron with the jewel of a Past Grand Master emblazoned upon its surface, may it be kept as an ever-present reminder of the simple lessons it inculcates, a neverending argument for nobler deeds, higher thoughts, and for purest actions.

May it canopy you with humility and grace, may you cleave even closer to the Craft, may you continue to serve as an elder statesman of the body, as a useful citizen in your community, ever loyal to your God, your country, your neighbor, and yourself. May the Almighty bless and keep you, Charles D.Doty. May the rest of your days befilled with good health, happiness and prosperity.

Freemasonry, deriving its symbolism from the

religious associations of the Ancient Mysteries, presents death to the neophyte as the gate or entrance to an eternal existence. We learn that life here is the time of labor, and that working at the construction of a spiritual temple, we are worshipping and praising the Grand Architect, for whom we build that temple. We learn further, that when life is ended, it closes only to open upon a newer and higher one, where the Mason, as the Christian, finds eternal truth in a spiritual temple not made with hands eternal in the heavens. Death, therefore, in Masonic philosophy is the symbol of intiation completed, perfected, and consummated.

To the grave we have consigned the mortal remains of our deceased brothers, we cherish their memory here, and as we commend their spirit to God, who gave it, we call upon that Ancient Teacher of Freemasonry, who has said, "It is appointed unto all men once to die, and after death cometh the resurrection. The dust shall return to the earth and the spirit unto God who gave it. In the grave all men are equal; the good deeds, the lofty thoughts, the heroic sacrifices alone survive and bear fruit in the lives of those who strive to emulate them.

While, therefore, nature will have its way, and our tears will fall upon the graves of our brethren, let us be reminded by the evergreen symbol of our faith in immortal life that the dead are but sleeping and be comforted by the reflection that their memories will not be forgotten; that they will still be loved by those who are soon to follow them; that in our archives their names are written, and that in our hearts there is still a place for them. And so, trusting in the infinite love and tender mercy of him without whose knowledge not even a sparrow falls, let us prepare to meet them where there is no parting and where with them we shall enjoy eternal rest."

Masonry is founded on the very wants of the nature of man. When man emerged from the hand of the Grand Architect of the U niverse, there was implanted within him a desire for society and social intercourse. The declaration of God, that, " it is not good for man to be alone" applies not only to the individual but to all classes of society.

Through the ages that have rolled into eternity since God created man, and looked upon everything that he had made, and pronounced it "very good" down to the present, this longing for social intercourse has maintained its position in the human breast, and property man with noble aspirations and desires to elevate himself and his fellow—man in the scale of moral and social being. It is true that there are some who have none of these heaven = born aspirations or desires within their breasts, who are content to grovel in ignorance, superstition and bigotry. Such men can never or should never become Masons.

It was the common pulsations of the heart of our common humanity that laid the corner stone of the Masonic institution, that has placed block upon block in the walls of this stupendous temple, and that will continue to infuse life and energy into the hearts of those who bow at its alters, until the temple shall have been completed in all its parts - the keystone having been placed in its proper position - the delta stone illuminated - both of them monuments to the wisdom of its founders and builders - its pillars strong and enduring and beauty being inscribed thereon in indelible characters.

It is definitely in the hallowed atmosphere of such a spiritual temple that the spirit of the great patron saint of Freemasonry - St. John the Baptist "- moves and abides. Of him, Christ has said, "Verily I say unto you, among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist; not withstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater that ne".

His virtues were so exemplary, so honorable, su useful to mankind, are acceptable to God that they should ever be held by men and Masons in grantful, humble rememberance.

In this temple the tenests of our fraternity are taught. First, it is an institution founded by men. - not of Divine origin - but upon Divine principles which underlies wall that is purely noble and good in humanity. The object being to educate men and to develop them in all faculties

of their nature that tend to bring peace and harmony to the muman family, and to elevate mankind to the highest attainable condition to which it is possible for human agencies and institutions to raise him. The teachings are pure and holy, designed to fill the soul of the initiate with higher conception of those duties which every man owes to himself, to his fellow - man and to his God. He is taught that to himself he owes the sacred duty of refraining from all indulgences which tend to impair his faculties and degrade his being; to be temperate in his desires and to rid his mind of the vices and superfluities of life.

To his fellow - man he is taught to act upon principles of brotherly love, relief and truth. Love to all mankind but especially to the brotherhood is strongly advocated and inculcated. The unity and harmony that pervade the universe, that give rise to the orderly movements of the sun, moon, earth and all life in our terrestrial and celestial spheres prove to the Msaon that they should be essential and conspicuous elements in his cheracter. It is such unity that gives permanence to our Fraternity.

Finally when we do not learn the lessons nor abide in this spiritual temple as we ought, do we ourselves, to a great extent not cause the objections to and criticisms of our beloved institution?

Do we attend to our duties as Masons as we ought? Do we live up to the principles of our Order that we profess to love and cherish?

Fellow Craftsmen, it is our duty to exemplify by our lives the noble principles of Masonry. Let us, in all our actions, make a constant, regular application of those principles, that others, seeing out good work, may be constrained to acknowledge the utility of Masonry, and that our influence, silent and humble, yet ever working, may draw to the support of our Fraternity, the good and true of every community. Take charity by the hand; do what ever she commands and a sweet peace will well up in your a faithful breasts. The widow's tears will engrave in indelible characters the benefits of Masonry. The mother's excited heart, the infants cries, and the orphan's thanks will answer all objections to the value of the Masonic Institution.

Learn, then, my brethren, the art of doing good, of building, of working together, of producing peace amidst the jarring elements of a disturbed, distraught world. Produce order out of choas and harmony out of discord. Learn to handle the tools of Masonry as you were taught. Apply them as the Master Craftsman ordains that you should.

When you can lask out over the rivers, the hills and the far horizon with a profound sense of our own littleness in the vast scheme of things, realizing that we are but fragments in the wonderous universe, and yet have faith, hope and courage you have learned the lesson taught by our Patron Saint.

Your learning and application are further manifested when you learn to sympathize with men in their sorrows, knowing that all men fight a hard fight against many odds. When you stretch forth your hands to support a fallen brother, when you whisper good counsel in his ear and in the most tender manner remind him of his faults and endeavor to aid his reformation, when you do not compete with him for his titles and honors but compete for better understanding, agreement and co - operation, when no voice of distress reaches your ears in vain, when no hand seeks aid without response, when you can see some good in all men then you have become great in the Masonic Institution.

Then when the dim lamp of life is expiring, when we are about to close our labors in the lodge below to join the celestial lodge above, where the Grand Architect of the Universe presides, we shall feel conscious of having performed our work well, wquaring it by the devices known to Masons, and be happy, knowing we are in possession of the pass - words which will gain us admission into that lodge of the just, the true, and the good, being duly and truly prepared to become associated with those true craftsmen who have gone before. - A body of just men made perfect.

Daniel Webster has said, " If we work upon marble, it will perish; if we work upon brass, time will efface it; but, if we work upon immortal minds; if we imbue them with principles, with the just fear of God and love for our fellow # men, we engrave on those tablets something which will brighten eternity."

### RESOLUTION

Whereas, Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code requires that some very specific statements be included in our Articles of Incorporation; and

Whereas, The last amendment (May 26, 1950) did not include any such statements,

Resolved, That the ninety-third annual communication should amend the Articles of Incorporation; further

Resolved, That the following changes be included as part of the amendments:

1. ARTICLE I

#### NAME.

The name of the Fraternity shall be "The Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge, Free and Accepted Masons, Jurisdiction of Minnesota, Incorporated." Otherwise known as: "...Prince Hall Grand Lodge, F. & A. M. Minnesota, Inc."

2. ARTICLE II PURPOSE/OBJECTIVE

The objectives of the Fraternity are:

- 1. To develop effective leadership within the Fraternity
- 2. Exclusively, to provide charitable and educational opportunities for the communities of the Fraternity within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal revenue Code.
- 3. INUREMENT OF INCOME: No part of the net ernings of the Fraternity shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered.
- 4. <u>LEGISLATIVE OR POLITICAL ACTIVITIES</u>: No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall notparticipate in or intervene (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- 5. OPERATIONAL LIMITATIONS: Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) By a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) By a corporation contributions, to which

are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

6. DISSOLUTION CLAUSE: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, The Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine.

Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

IT IS BASED ON A FIRM BELIEF IN THE FATHERHOOD OF GOD, THE BROTHERHOOD OF MAN & THE IMMORTALITY OF THE SOUL. IT TEACHES TOLERANCE TOWARD THE BELIEFS OF OTHERS & CHARITY TOWARD ALL MANKIND. MASONRY IS NOT A POLITICAL ORGANIZATION. IT DOES NOT INTEREST ITSELF IN PARTY POLITICS WITHIN ITS WALLS. BUT, OUTSIDE THE LODGE HALL A BROTHER BECOMES A CITIZEN. EARLY IN 1950, GRAND MASTER CHARLES D. DOTY HAD RECEIVED LETTERS AND PETITIONS FROM A GROUP OF IRREGULAR MASONIC BRETHREN LIVING IN SIOUX FALLS, SOUTH DAKOTA. THEY DESIRED REGULAR AFFILIATION WITH THE INVESTIGATION REVEALED THAT THEY HAD MADE NO PETITIONS TO OTHER PRINCE HALL BODIES, THEIR NUMBER WAS SMALL, BUT THEIR PRAYER WAS FERVENT AND THEIR HOPES WERE COURAGEOUS. ON TUESDAY MAY 30, 1950, BROTHER DOTY WITH SEVENTEED TWIN CITY MASONS JOURNEYED TO SIOUD FALLS, S.D. WHERE HE OPEN AN OCCASIONAL LODGE AND ENTERED, PASSED AND RAISED SEVEN BROTHERS TO THE SUBLIME DEGREE OF THE GRAND MASTER SUPERVISED THE ELECTION OF THE MASTER MASON. CHARTER OFFICERS WHO WERE: MAURIICE COAKLEY, W. M., DAN COATED, S.W., THE NAME ALPHA LODGE U. D. WAS SELECTED. (AFTER GEORGE BUSH, J.W. PRESENTING RITUALISTIC EQUIPMENT AND INSTRUCTION, THE GRAND MASTER CLOSED THE LODGE. AN EXCELLENT BANQUET WAS SERVED BY THE SIOUX FALLS LADIES IN ST. JOHN'S BAPTIST CHURCH. ALPHA LODGE, HAVING FUNCTIONED PROPERLY, WAS ENUMERATED NO. 10 BY THE 1950 GRAND LODGE. "TID BIT!" "TID BIT!" LETS TALK ABOUT RETIREMENT.



WHAT ARE WE GOING TO DO ABOUT THE GRAVE OF THE FIRST BLACK GRAND MASTER?

The United Supreme is the governing body of Scottish Rite Masonry and the Golden Circle. This Supreme Countil is not a ridy of delegates. It is not created by subordinate bodies, but creates them. It is the sole source of their government as well as its own. It perpetuates itself by elevating to the Thirty-Third Degree those Thirty-Second Degree Masons who have given outstanding service to Masonry or the community or country. Selecting from among those so elevated, a certain number serve as administrators of the Rite. These administrators classified as "active members" (wearing Purple and White Crowns) possess the power of transacting all legislative business and have absolute control in direction of the rite in the jurisdiction of the Supreme Council.

When one is elevated from the Thirty-Second Degree to the Thirty-Third Degree, he is given the grade of honorary member of the Supreme Council with a title known as Grand Inspector General. When one is selected from among the Grand Inspectors General to be an "active" member or an administrator of the rite, he is given the title of Sovereign Grand Inspector General. In each state you will find at least one Sovereign Grand Inspector General, the Deputy and maybe others. This Sovereign Grand Inspector General does not represent his Valley in the Supreme Council, but he does represent the Supreme Council in his Valley or Orient. He has no authority unless he is Deputy.

The Council of Deliberation consists of all the Scottish Rite
Bodies in the state. The State Grand Assembly consists of all the
Golden Circle Assemblies in the state, with the III. Deputy (Most
III. Commander-in-Chief) in charge of both organizations. The
Council of Deliberation consists of all Sovereign and Grand Inspectors
General of whatever grade residing in the State; duly elected officers
of said Councils; all Past Commanders-in-Chief of Consistories in the
State; the first three officers for the time being of Consistories;
the first three officers of Chapters of Rose Croix and the first
four officers of Lodges of Perfection.

The Grand Assembly shall consist of all present elected and appoint ed Grand Officers, all Past Grand Officers, Present Loyal Lady Rulers, present Loyal Lady Associate Rulers and present Loyal Lady Priestesse of subordinate Assemblies and all Past Loyal Lady Rulers. Any Loyal Lady who is in good standing in a subordinate assembly may attend the Grand Assembly Meetings as an associate member and may serve on Grand

Subject: The proper way of introducing the Grand Master and his Cabinet. The Tyler will inform the Master that the Grand Master and his Officers are ready to be admitted. The Stewards will take their stations at the Door, one on each side, with rods crossed. When the Door is opened the Master will rap up the Lodge. The Deacons will take their stations at the alter with their rous crossed. The Grand Officers will enter the Lodge, according to their rank(DAM, Sr.W, JW, GL, etc.) down the line, as they enter the door, the Grand Logger of ficers Will break off and start to form two parallel lines to the alter. If there is any space left, the Brothers from the Lodge will fill up the vacant space. After the two lines are formed the Grand Master will enter. He will be escerted by the Grand Marshall, or if he is absent, by the Marshall from the Lodge, to the alter. When he is at the west of the alter, the Master will then introduce him. (Brothers I am happy to introduce you to the Honorable Grand Master, Robert H. Johnson, or who ever the Grand Master might be at the time). The Master will then order the Marshall and the Deacons to escort the Grand Master to the east. When the Grand Master is in the east the Master will say, "Brothers assist me in giving the Grand Master his Honors." After the honors are given, the Master will then say, "Grand Master behold your Craft, Craft behold your Grand Master." The Master will then present the Gavel to the Grand Master. The Grand Master will then order that the rest of his Cabinet be brought in and introduced. Past Grand Masters next, if there are any, and so on down the line. After they are all placed in their proper stations they will all be given their Grand Honors.

Furthurmore do I promise and swear, that I will never open a Lodge of Laster Lasons unless there be present three regular Easter Lasons, besides the Tyler; nor close the same without giving a lecture, or some section or part of the instruction of the lodge. To all of which I do most solemnly and sincerely promise and swear, with a fixed and steady purpose of mind to keep and perform the same; binding myself under no less penaltythan ( in addition to all my former penalities) to have my tongue split from tip to root, that I might forever thereafter. be unable to pronounce the word, should I in/in ever prove wilfully guilty of violating any part of this solemn oath, or obligation, of a Fast Laster Lason. So help me God, and make me steadfast to keep and perform the same. -- (candidate kisses the Holy Book five times) --STEP OFF WITH THE LEFT FOOT, AND PLACE THE HEEL OF THE RIGHT FOOT AT THE TOE OF THE LEFT, SO AS TO BRING THE TWO FEET AT RIGHT ANGLES. I KNOW,, SOME MEMBERS OF THE SOJOURNERS ARE NOT PREJUD-ICED AND WOULD ACCEPT P. H. MS THEY TELL ME, THAT P. H. LODGES ARE USUALLY MORE POWERFUL, ACCEPTABLE AND RECOGNIZED ON BASES BY THE HIGHER RANKING OFFICERS THAN THE NAACP, PANTHERS, URBAN LEAGUE AND ALLIED ORGANIZATIONS. THE MILITARY FAMILY SHOULD TEND TO TAKE CARE OF ITS OWN IN ALL FOLDS: AND IF A TYPE OF PROBLEM ARISES, IT CAN BE SAID THAT WHEN THE PRECEPTS OF MASONRY CAN BE USED TO THE SATIS-FACTION OF ALL PARTIES,, ARRANGEMENTS CAN BE MADE,, INSTEAD OF MILITARY PUNISHMENTS. HOWEVER, ONLY BY KNOWING ALL PARTIES CONCERNED,, WHO ARE IN THE MASONIC FAMILY CAN THIS PROCEDURE BE USED.

THE YOUNG SGT. BLACK ESPECIALLY, IS NOT A MASON FOR VARIOUS REASONS, KNOWN TO US IN THE FAMILY. JUSTA AS THE YOUNG BLACK DOES NOT KNOW HIS OWN HISTORY, CULTURE AND BLACK AIRMAN HISTORY, HE KNOWS NOTHING OF WHY A BLACK MASON IS A BETTER MAN, BETTER FATHER OR AIRMAN. HE DOES NOT KNOW WHAT PART P. H. HAS PLAYED IN THE NEGROES. PAST, CONSEQUENTLY, HE HAS NO REASON TO SEEK OUT THE MASONIC FAMILY IN HIS HOME TOWN, STATE OR IN THE ARMED FORCES.. I THINK THE MILITARY LODGES SHOULD TRY TO ENCOURAGE THE YOUNGER PROMISING AIRFORCE PERSONNEL ,,,, BY SOCIAL AFFAIRS, HOME VISITS AND BLACK Gurman 9 EDUCATE HIM TO RECOGNIZE HIS HERITAGE OF BEING A PRINCE HALL MASON.

I HAVE TO JUST TOUCH UPON SUBJECTS, , INDEPENDENCE AND FREEDOM OF SPEECH.

THESE ARE TWO OF THE THINGS THAT OUR COUNTRY WAS FOUNDED ON., AMERICANS HAVE FOUGHT
FOR OVER THREE HUNDRED YEARS FOR THESE PRINCIPLES. OUR ARM FORCES HAVE FOUGHT, SO
WE CEVILINS CAN HAVE INDEPENDENCE & FREEDOM OF SPEECH., BUT IN THE AIR FORCE,
IF YOU DESIRE THESE THINGS

DISOBEDIENCE. & IF YOU DEMAND THESE RIGHTS IT WILL GET YOU A COURT-MARTIAL.

I SUPPOSE YOU ALL HAVE READ ABOUT BRIG. GEN. DANIEL "CHAPPIE" JAMES & M/SGT. WILLIAM SPEIGHT, WHO IS THE PRESIDENT OF THE NAT'L BROTHER HOOD ASSN. OF MILITARY AIRMEN (BAMA). DID YOU READ BOUT THE PROGRAM RECENTLY HELD AT THE AIR FORCE ACADEMY, REPORTED ON IN EBONY MAGAZINE. THIS COULD BE A THEME, COURAGE AND DETERMENATION .. YOU KNOW ABOUT GENERAL "CHAPPIE JAMES" USAF .. A SOUL BROTHER, WHO IS MAKING IT BIG IN HIS CHOSEN PROFESSION AS A LOYAL AMERICAN AND CAREER AIRMAN. AFTER GRADUATING FROM TUSKEEGEE INSTITUTE. HE WAS A SINGLE,, ENGINE FIGHTER PILOT IN THE THEN, SEGREGATED AIR FORCE, THE 99thPURSUIT SQUADRON: THEN, SQUADRON COMMANDER IN THE INTERGRATED AIR DEFENSE COMMAND, FIGHTER INTERCEPTOR SQUADRON. AS AN OPERATIONS OFFICER IN "NAM" FLYING WINC, , MAN MISSIONS DAILY WITH HIS SQUADRON, HE IS NOW BRIG. GENERAL STATIONED IN THE PENTAGON. NOW THERE IS A REAL LEADER WITH INNER COURAGE AND DETERMINATION WHO HAS LET HIS LIGHT SHINEAND PERHAPS SOME OF YOU WILL SEE THE LIGHT AND WANT TO FOLLOW HIS PHILOSOPH OF GETTING AHEAD IN HIS CHOSEN PROFESSION. TO YOU THAT ARE LEADERS, I FEEL THAT YOU MUST KNOW YOUR MEN AS INDIVIDUALS AND AS A WORKING GROUP: KNOW THEIR SOCIAL GROUP BEHAVIORALOS. LEADERS ARE MEN WHO "DO", "WHO TEACH" & NOT JUST ORDER. LET YOURLIGHT SHOWAND INSPIRE OTHERS, SO THAT OTHERS CAN SEE AND WANT TO BE LIKE YOU OR AT LEAST FOLLOW YOUR EXAMPLE. \*\*\* NOW I TOUCH ON ANOTHER SUBJECT: STICK WITH ME, TECH NO LOG ICAL SKILLS, OFF, TIME FORMAL EDUCATIONIS THE BEST WAY TO GET WITH IT. SOME USE THE CLUBS PROVIDED ON BASE OR WORKING IN YOURLODGE CAN BE A MEANS OF COMMUNICATION BETWEEN PERSONS OF SIMILAROBJECTIVES. (THINK IT OVER & YOU WILL GET WHAT I MEAN). JUST TO KNOW YOU AREA MEMBER OF A GROUP, ALL WORKING FOR GOALS, IS INSPIRING TO THE VALUE OF TOGETHERNESS. (NOW LISTEN TO ME) NOTHING TEMORARY CAN BE AS SATISFYING AS A PERMANENT GOAL. WHAT CAN BE A BETTER GOAL THAN TRYING THE LADDER. DO YOU REMEMBER SINGING, WE ARE CLIMBING. JACOB'S LADDER. CLIMBING TOWARD THE APEX OF A TRIANGLE?

WE CANNOT UNDERESTIMATE THE POWER OF FORMAL EDUCATION AND ITS IMPORTANCE TO TEC NOIXE LOGICAL TRAINING. I UNDER STAND THAT NO LONGER WILL THE AIR FORCE BE A HAVEN FOR THE "DROP OUT". I UNDERSTAND ALL ENLISTED AIRMEN WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA UNON ENTERING THE SERVICE, OR AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AFTER ENTERING THE SERVICE. I UNDERSTAND ALL CAREER N.C.O.'S ARE ENCOURAGED TO COMPLETE TWO YEARS OF COLLEGE EQUIVALENT STUDY BEFORE THEIR 15th YEAR OF SERVICE. EVEN THE OFFICER GAP WILL BE AUTHORIZED 18 MONTHS FOR COMPLETION OF A BACCALBUREATE DEGREE, AFTER ENTERING THE SERVICE. HOW'S YOU OWN OPERATION BOOT, STRAP? ARE YOU GETTING IT ALL TOGETHER ?? DO YOU KNOW WHAT SOME OF THE OBJECTIONS ARE TO AN ALL, VOLUNTEER ARMED FORCE ARE?? AN ALL, VOLUNTEER, WILL BE MOSTLY BLACK OR DOMINATED BY MEN FROM LOW INCOME BACKGROUNDS. A ALL VOLUNTEER FORCE REQUIRES A SUB STANTIAL INCREASE IN FIRST, TERM MILITARY PAY: THEREBY INCREASES THE ATTRACTIVENESS OF MILITARY SERVICE AMONG LOWER INCOME GROUPS, , INCLUDING BLACKS. WHITES ARE CONCERNED WITH THE DANGERS OF HAVING A COMMUNITY OF A LARGE NUMBER OF BLACKS WHO HAVE HAD MILITARY TRAINING:: WHAT IF THESE BLACKS PARTICIPATE IN RIOTS AND CIVIL DISTRUBANCE??

I CLOSE WITH THIS STATEMENT: WE ON THE OUTSIDE SHOULD HELP EDUCATE

THE COMMUNITY WHERE WE LIVE IN. LET US THEREFORE, FOLLOW AFTER THE THINGS

WHICH MAKE FOR PEACE. AND UNTIL THERE IS NO MORE WAR, IT BEHOOVES US TO

BE PREPARED. OUR ORGANIZATION, THE MASONIC FAMILY, WILL NEVER STOP STRIVING

FOR PEACE, THE GRAND ARCHITECT DEMANDS THIS OF US. AS A GROUP, I ADMONISH

YOU TO LABOR FOR PEACE, BUT BE READY TO DEFEND YOUR WORK. WE ON THE OUT

### PROPOSED SPEECH

Not to confuse you, but only to establish the keystone or foundation for my words - I am not a Chaplain, but I am a firm believer of the chaplaincy. Yet, the Chaplains need assistance; mayke you are the one To help.

I am not a Base Commander, Wing Commander, Squadron Commander, nor a lower-grade Airman, but you can see that in my position as Most Worshipful Grand Master, I have held similar, comparable grades in rising to my honoured office. And I share the frustrations and exaltations in performing my duties with you, for they must be similar to yours.

I have had to know and accept those higher values of life that effect the way the best of humans must perform, and I'm sure these values are most valid, now and in the future.

You must know the personal fullfillment and happiness will be the harvest of a genuine response to values, which mean a genuine relationship with God, neighbor, self and your world.

And as a guide, I refer you to and implore you to read the March 1972 Ebony Magazine, and then pass it on to all your fellow Airmen and Officers, so they may read it also.

Independence or Autonomy is merely being indepently free from the rule of others, free from wrong influence, control, or determination of others. The opposite of independence is dependences. The common definition of dependence is the state of being contingent upon or influenced, controlled, or determined by something else. In the Air Force it is called, Insubordination, or not being in accord with authority or disobedience! You need that name as you would " no hands " or " hole in the head ", or a Court-Martial.

We must build a dynamic organization by "rapping about our mission and the importance of each man's duty to that mission. Such is the program with Brig. Gen. Daniel "Chappie" James and M/Sgt. William Speight, who is the President of the Nat'l Brotherhood Assn. of Military Airmen (BAMA), held recently at the Air Force Academy reported in Ebony Magazine.

So, we men stress values such as courage, inner direction, certain forms of aggression, autonomy (Independence) mastery of technological skill, group solidarity, and adventure of toughness of mind and body.

Courage is the attitude of response to facing and dealing with anything recognized as difficult, dangerous, instead of withdrawing from it, and your response results from inner direction.

We know the feeling of being faint of heart or experiencing lack of courage, but mostly we know the continuing feeling of the survival of the mind and body, of confident courage in dealing with the everyday routine, and that extra burst of (courage) adrenline when confronted with the unusual. That, my brother, results from the inner man's direction being prepared to cope with emregencies.

You and I are fortunate as a member of organizations of the home, schools, churches and fraternal - and let me say here, that I know the United States Air Force is a fraternal organization - just as we of the Masonic family are, that believe in inner courage as the way to cope with the hassles of life and job. Let me give you one example: You know about General "Chappie James" USAF - a soul brother - who is making it big in his chosen profession as a loyal American and Career Airman. After graduating from Tuskeegee Institute, he was a Single - Engine fighter pilot in the then, segregated Air Force, the 99th Pursuit Squadron; then, Squadron Commander in the intergrated Air Defense Command, Fighter Interceptor Squadron. As an Operations Officer in "NAM" flying wingman missions daily with his Squadron, he is now Brig. General stationed in the Pentagon.

Now there is a real leader with inner courage who has let his light shine and perhaps you will see the light and want to be like him, or at least, want to follow his philosophy of getting ahead in his chosen profession.

When we have self-respect or the sense of one's own dignity or worth - that is reflected in our daily living and work - that is wholesome pride. Pride in being a worthy man belonging to a worthy society and organization pushing forward a goal of perfection is so very commendable. What I want to emphasize is remember what we can identify with - Proudly!

Nothing phony is acceptable, nothing so phony that it stinks.

We must watch for false prophets or instant experts with a solution for everything, or a phony hero or saint.

And we must never ourselves become what we reid; the false prophet, the instant expert, or phony hero. Rather we must have that inner courage to reach out to the troubled, despondent; depressed with the inner courage to develop a sense of awareness, because our organization lives within itself and draws its strength from the social group, we must know the score because we can't properly act upon any situation without knowing something about that situation.

Aggression or aggressiveness in the human should mean "full of enterprise and initiative, bold behavior "and
not the kind of belief most commonly held as the use of
unprovoked attack or invasion. I'm sure you've heard enough
of that (provocation) when faced with the allegation of
starting quarrels or fights.

After we are trained in the basic landmarks of living with others, and trained in our chosen vocation, job or profession, we have the opportunities to display our potentialities. Among those values is enterprise in carrying on our projects, or participation in undertakings with iniitiative, or the willingness to take a chance, or think and act without being hassled. This is known as having the "initiation". All of us have been initiated, most with everlasting effect upon our lives. Thus, our bold behavior was made known as we were searching for Truth and were aggressive in our search. How many of us still show that type of aggressiveness and, and not resorting to invasion?

We need less arguments, confrontations or everyday hassles! Can you do it? I mean, become involved with others without hassling them? And yet be aggressive in the true sense of the word?

We, as leaders, must know our men as individuals and as a working group; know their social group behavior. Leaders are men who " do " as well as " teach " or just " give an order ". Your inner courage must show and inspire others. " Let your light shine ", so that others can see and want to be like you or at least follow your example.

Yet, as individuals, we require some periods of time of being, independent, free from the wrong control or influence of the wrong things, and yet free to use your leisure time in the manner you desire. Sports, or other leisure time activities, when used constructively can enhance the man. Off-time formal education or use of the Social Clubs provided on Base or working in your lodge can be a means of communication between persons of similar attitudes.

Just to know you are a member of a group of your peers, all working for the same goals is inspiring to the value of togetherness. Technological skills is the means by which we choose our vocations, jobs and resulting in our duty to society and ourselves.

And now to the question of "Why do I have to work."

Let me refer you to the Bible and the story of the expulsion of Adam and Eve from the garden, and the consequence of man living by the sweat of his brow, and being told the worker earns his pay - which means that if you don't work, perhaps you won't eat. And when hunger pains strike, some steal, but most of us work. In choosing a vocation, certain factors should enter into our choice. They are:

1. What shall I aim for?

- 2. Will the job give me the inner conviction I need?
- 3. Will it be constructive in the jobs service to me and my fellow men?
- 4. Will the job provide me with adequate resources to maintain myself and my family, which I hope to have?
- 5. Will the training for the job and the job itself, utilize to the maximum degree my inate talents and training?

It seems as if all of us here in the room have made our choice of vocation or profession and I hope for the reasons listed above - and not just as a temporaty station.

Nothing temporary can be as inner satisfying as a permanent goal! What can be a better goal than trying the ladder, climbing toward the apex of a triangle?

We cannot underestimate the power of formal education and its importance to technological training. I understand that no longer will the Armed Forces be a haven for the "Drop-Out" or "Give Ups", for I understand all enlisted airmen will be required to have a High School Diploma upon entering the service, or as soon as possible after entering the Service. I understand all Career N.C.O.'s are encouraged to complete 2 years of college equivalent study before their 15th year of service. Even the Officer Gap will be authorized 18 months for completion of a Baccalaureate Degree, after entering the Service. How's your own Operation Boot-Strap - are you getting it all together?

3 Group solidarity is the completely unified membership of any organization, as of opinion, purposes, interest, feeling....

Man is a social being. His moral behavior, elaborate philosophy to promote it; his customs and laws designed to enforce it, has arisen from the basic necessity of cooperation for survival. Survival can only be achieved by a group and this group must have solidarity. The lessions of History, Anthropology show that many nations, cities, families have been destroyed by the same thing which made them great. And yet man continues, in his life, against being destroyed, continues his group associations.

Let me give you what I consider a pressing fact concerning the Report of the Presidents Commission on an All-Volunteer Armed Force, Chapter 12. Objections to an All-Voluntter Force -And I quote " An All-Voluntter will be all black or dominated by service men from low income backgrounds. Recognition that moves to an all Volunteer Force requires a sub - stantial increase in first-term military pay; thereby increases the attractiveness of military service previously among lower income groups - including blacks. Some whites are concerned with the dangers of having a community of a large number of blacks who have had military training; resulting in participation of these blacks in riots and civil disturbance. However, the black community fear a loss of black male drain". Now, let me add according to State Department figures during time of war, a desproportionate number of Black men join the Armed Forces, and suffer proportionately higher casualties than do whites. This was especially true for Vietnam where many blacks faced combat.

This is controversal, some would say not to even bring it up, but in your chosen job or profession we need to know as much about it as possible. Think about it for just a few minutes. Now, your vocation is an honourable profession and is referred to in both the O.T. and N.T. writings as "War" and as "Peace".

The biblical verse you may consider is Romans 15:1. Those of us who have a robust conscience must accept as our own burden the tender scruples of weaker men; and not consider ourselves. Each of us must consider his neighbor and think what is for his good and will build up the common life, and coupled with Romans 14:19 - Let us therefore, follow after the things which make for peace.

Now, if we can use the Bible as the pattern for life there must come a time when war may be necessary. If we are to fight this war, would it not be better to serve in a solid group of professionals, completely unified in membership by volunteer service; trained in its purpose; of the same opinion that the best can win; with the same interest in doing the best job possible as a completely unified group? You can compare this type group with a less solid group, even a mob group and see the difference it could make to you as well as your country.

Just as a group may make war, the same group may be a deterent to war or even keep the Peace. And until there is no more war, it behooves us to be prepared. Our organization, the Masonic Family, will never stop striving for peace, for which the Grand Architect demands of us while laboring, from which we must never retire to recreation. As one group, I admonish you to labor for Peace, but be ready to defend your work.

Adventure or a happening of the unusual, stirring experience of the mind and body, or being prepared to (overcome) combat the unforseen human experiences.

Man's greatest adventure must be just trying to understand himself. In understanding himself is the recognition of how he has developed his beliefs. The manner in which a person has developed his beliefs affects the way he views the world, thus making him more or less susceptible to conflicts and problems.

It is the unusual, stirring experiences of the mind that controls the body; when man learns to walk as a child; or is among the first to climb a mountain; or is among the first to see the moon as an inhabitant. He has that desire to answer that question of why? What? Where? and prepares himself as best he may, to see a possible answer to the unknown experiences he may encounter. Man is not yet a satisfied, fullfilled being; he must know what is just around the corner for himself .-The challenge of the impossible and man's reaction to that challenge. However, the Laws of God and man are designed to protect the would-be law breaker. All men are potential lawbreakers, either by ommission or commission. In spite of the law, the spirit of adventure is ever present. For man to play games with the game of adventure is known by those who win and by those who lose. Not much is said about those who just play the game, for we are the majority. We are the majority that are the landmarks of society, the ones who never give up and always give out our t lents, time, finances and moral support to those who win and to those who lose. So, you can see that all of us play the game of Adventure, and are either winners or losers, but with the self-satisfaction that we tried.

Where does that value come from? We have been and are continuing to have explained to us, by the principle that "Fraud of Human Pride" is disastrous - any fraud is disastrous. I'm not saying we should not have pride.
