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# MINUTES OF THE REGULAR AUGUST-1972 MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF GRAIN BELT BREWERIES, INC.

The regular August-1972 meeting of the Board of Directors of Grain Belt Breweries, Inc. was held at the office of the company, 1215 Marshall Street N.E., Minneapolis, Minnesota at 9:30 o'clock A.M. on Tuesday, August 29, 1972.

Mr. Frank D. Kiewel, Chairman of the Board, presided and C.R. Sievers, Jacted as Secretary.

#### ATTENDANCE

The following directors were present: Messrs. Lee Birdsong, Richard T. Burger, Calvin L. DeLaittre, Hy Finkelstein, Kenneth K. Foster, Anthony A. Gasser, Frank D. Kiewel, John P. Lampertz, Frank E. Mathes, Malcolm G. Pfunder and Carl R. Sievers, Jr. Mr. Edward M. Callinan, legal counsel, was also present.

### MINUTES APPROVED

A copy of the Minutes of the regular July-1972 Board meeting held on July 25, 1972 and the Special Meeting of the Board of Directors held on August 15, 1972 having been mailed to the respective directors, the reading of the Minutes of those meetings was waived.

A MOTION was made by Mr. Pfunder and seconded by Mr. Mathes to approve the Minutes of the regular July-1972 Board meeting and August 15, 1972 Special Board meeting as mailed.

The motion passed unanimously.

### COMPARATIVE SALES REPORT

The Secretary presented the current comparative sales report.

### LEE BIRDSONG REPORTS

Mr. Birdsong reported to the members of the Board on the latest developments in the possible sale of the Omaha plant but did not recommend the proposition presented by a group of Omaha businessmen. The Board concurred that the proposition should not be given further consideration.

Mr. Birdsong commented on the appraisal of the company's Omaha properties which had just recently been completed. The appraisal is now being studied in the light of possible real estate tax reductions and write-off for income tax purposes.

The results of a meeting involving a pending lawsuit against the company were given to the Board by Mr. Birdsong who represented the company at said meeting.

### REPORT OF SALARY COMMITTEE

In accordance with the consensus of the members of the Board at the May-1972 meeting of the Board of Directors, the Salary Committee again reviewed the salaries of the officers of the company. Messrs. Mathes and Sievers left the meeting while the recommendations of the Salary Committee were presented to the Board for changes in annual salaries to be paid on a monthly basis effective September 1, 1972 to the following officers of the corporation:

Messrs. Mathes and Sievers returned to the meeting and thanked the Board for their consideration.

Mr. Kiewel reminded the members of the Board of the luncheon to be held at the Golden Valley Golf Club in recognition of Mr. Birdsong's past services as an officer of the company and a member of the Board immediately following the adjournment of the meeting.

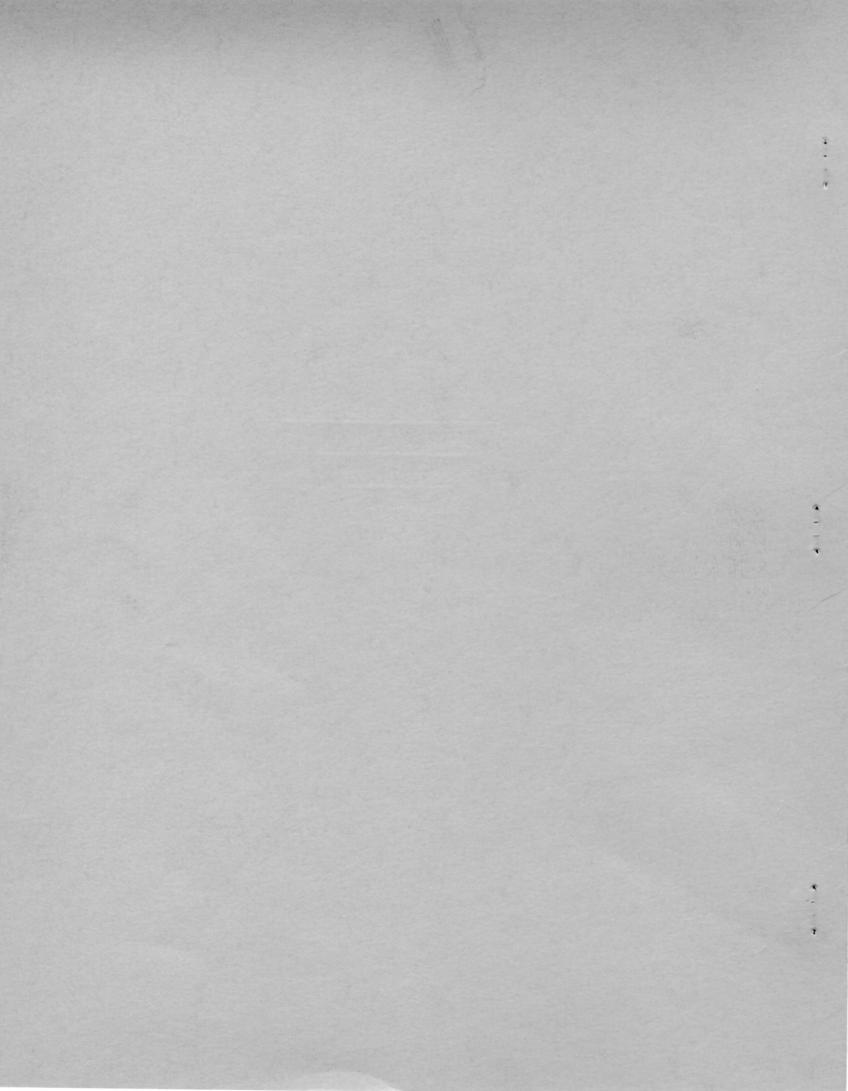
