Construction on the \$90 million GALTIER PLAZA, the major project in Lowertown at the present time, is proceeding at a fast pace. Four levels of below-ground parking for 815 cars, are nearly completed. Development components include approximately 100,000 square feet of retail stores, restaurants and four cinemas, all on three levels. Two high rise towers will contain 150 luxury condominium units and 350 first class rental apratments. A new 6-story YMCA with exceptional facilities will be included in the structure. Projected opening for the retail, office and YMCA areas of the Plaza is October, 1984; for the apartments and condominiums, early 1985.
