The 210-suite GRANADA ROYALE HOMETEL in Lowertown is the newest addition to Saint Paul's accommodations for conventioners, tourists and other visitors. The project was made possible by relocating the Farmers Market on a new site. A developer was recruited, the Market site was sold to the developer by the City, and a tax-exempted bond was provided by the Saint Paul Port Authority. The design of the HOMETEL structure was reviewed by the Lowertown Redevelopment Corporation and the City with the result that a more compatible design was constructed.
